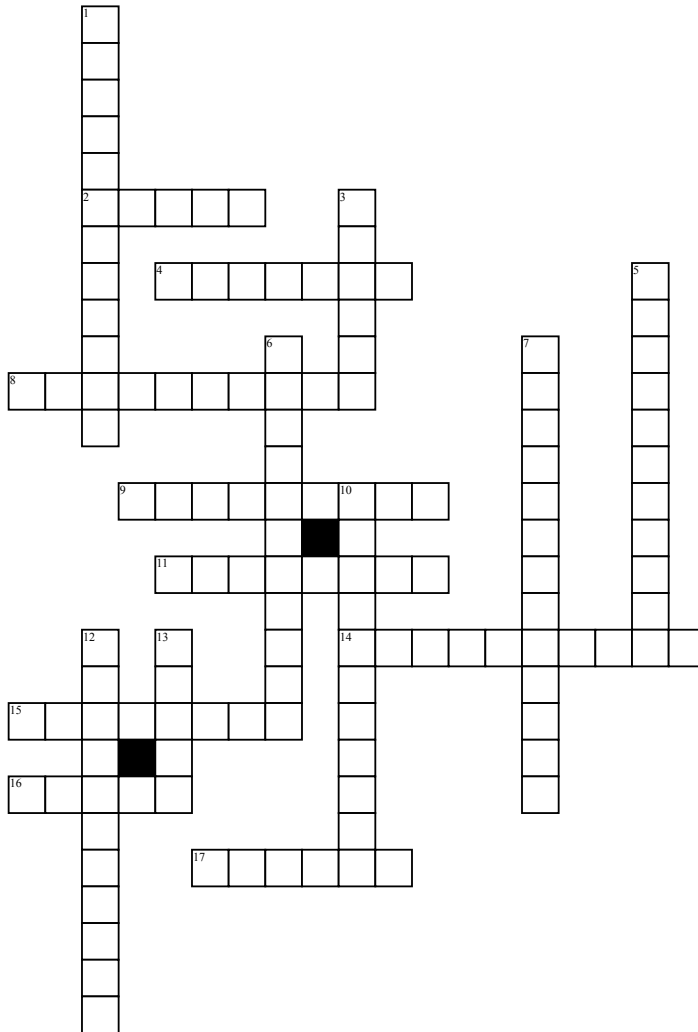


# 10.14 Crossword Puzzle
