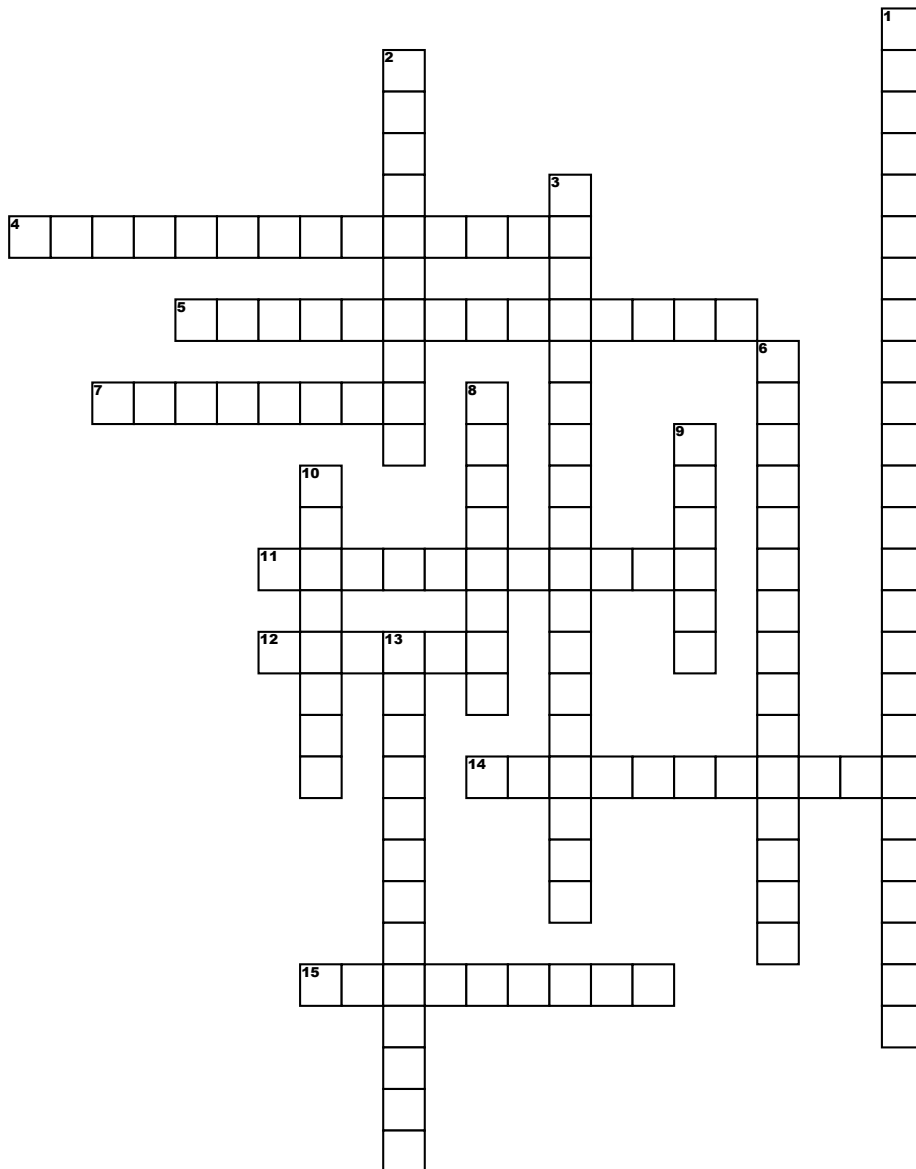

1. genetic disorder characterized by progressive muscle degeneration and weakness.

2. diagnose and treat conditions of the foot, ankle, and related structures of the leg.

3. the name for a group of conditions that cause blood cells, platelets, white blood cells, and red blood cells, to grow abnormally in the bone marrow.

6. also known as chest wall pain

8. capable of bending easily without breaking.

9. a cluster of seven articulating bones in each foot situated between the lower end of tibia and fibula of the lower leg and the metatarsus

10. situated in or affecting the area around the anus

13. a specific disorder of keratinization that is characterized histologically by the presence of a cornoid lamella, a thin column of closely stacked, parakeratotic cells extending through the stratum corneum with a thin or absent granular layer.
