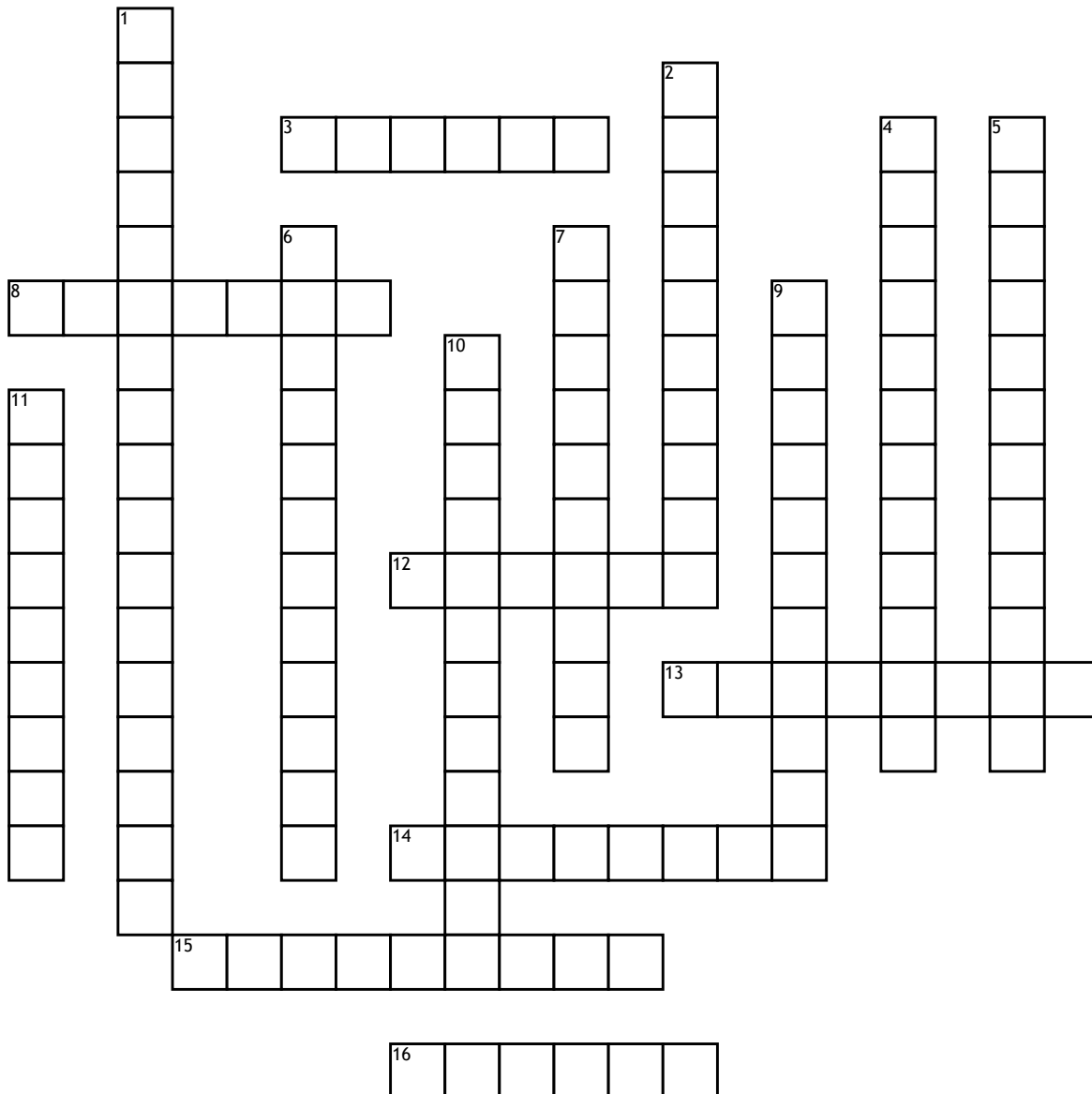

1. a form of muscular dystrophy in which the muscles become swollen with deposits of fat and fibrous tissue.

 4. an ill-defined medical condition characterized by lassitude, fatigue, headache, and irritability, associated chiefly with emotional disturbance

5. a chronic disorder characterized by widespread musculoskeletal pain, fatigue, and tenderness in localized areas.
