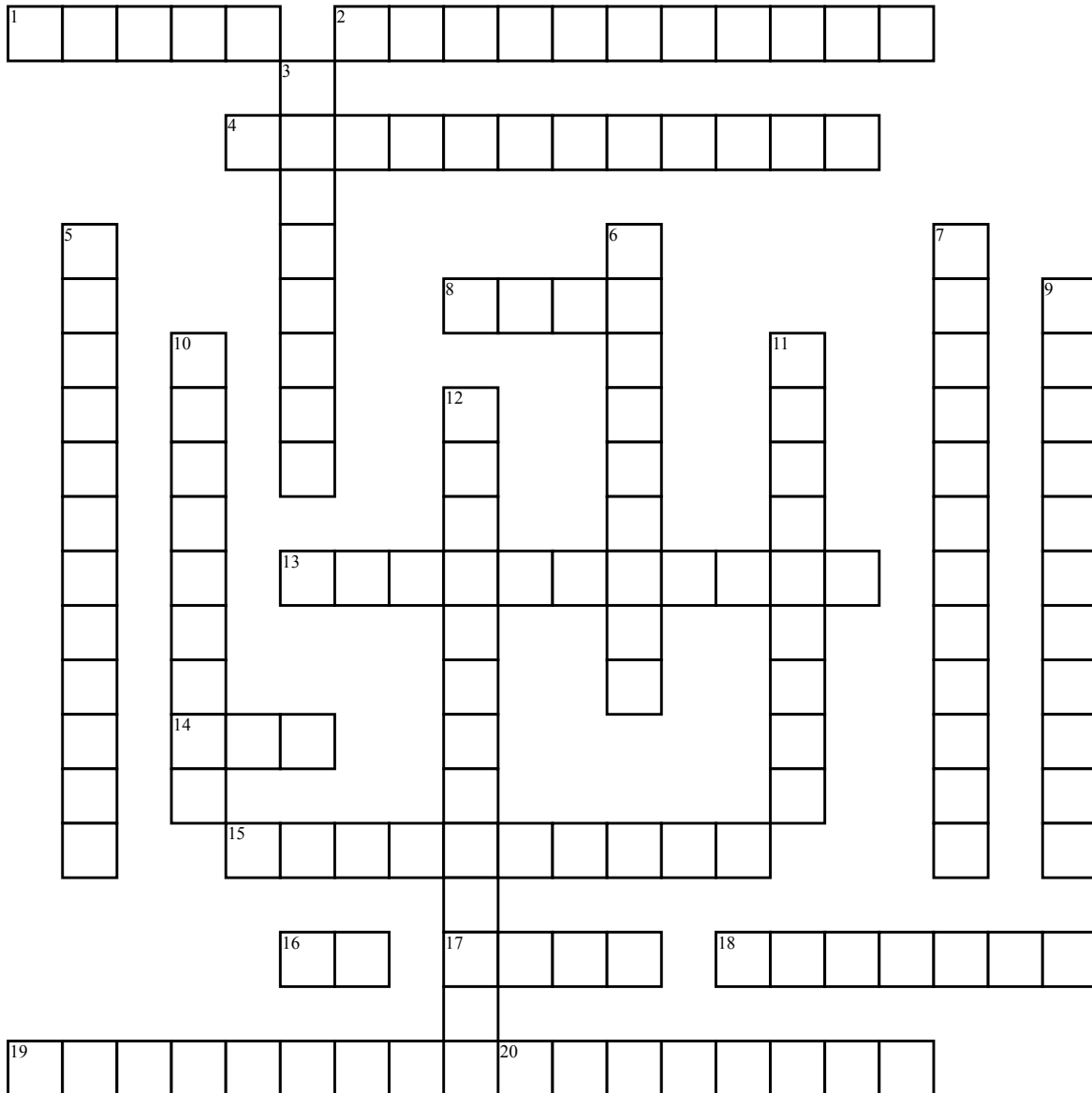


1950's crossword puzzle/Jordan Dixon
