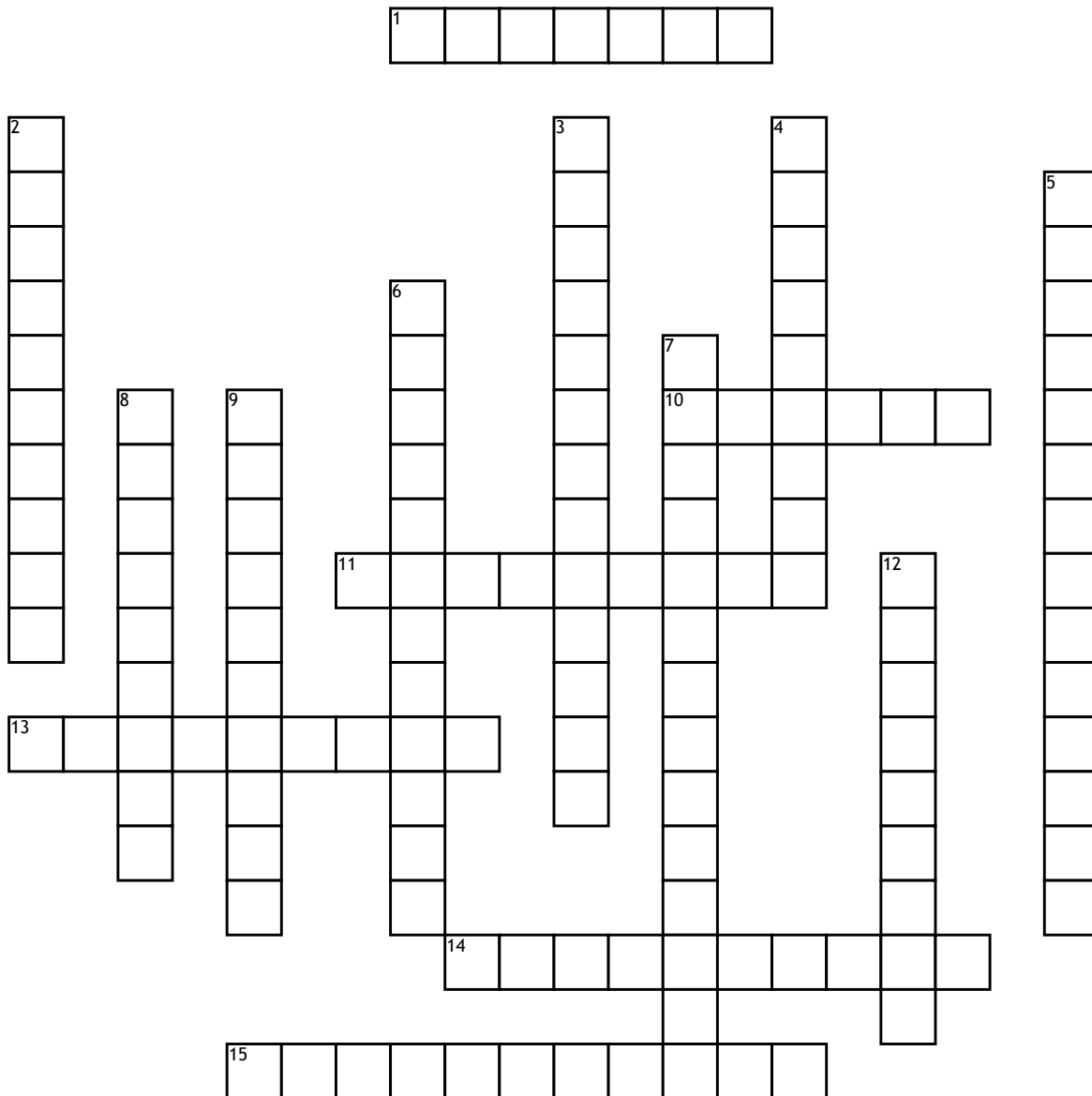

2. An instrument used to measure air capacity of the lungs.
3. A vein carrying oxygenated blood from the lungs to the left atrium of the heart.
4. Difficulty in speaking due to a disorder of the mouth, tongue, throat, or vocal cords.
5. A procedure to remove fluid from the space between lungs and chest.

6. Used for recording or measuring spectra.

7. Soft cartilage in larynx collapses during inhaling; soft larynx.
8. Lung inflammation caused by bacterial or viral infection.
9. Naval cavity is filled with a lot of mucus fluid; a runny nose.
