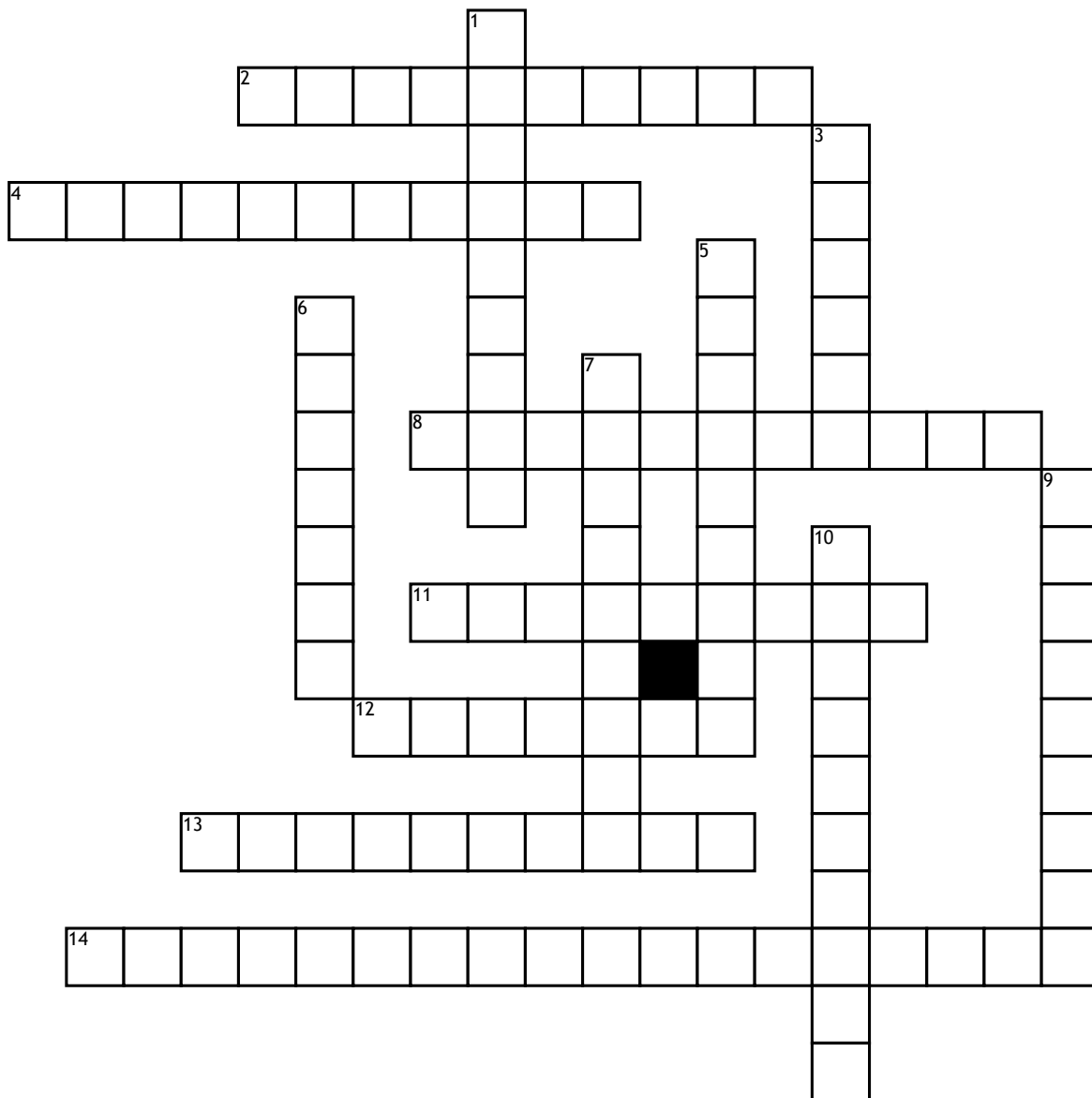

7. lung inflammation caused by bacterial or viral infection, in which the air sacs fill with pus and may become solid.

9. bleeding from the nose.

10. Inflammation of the lining of bronchial tubes, which carry air to and from the lungs.
