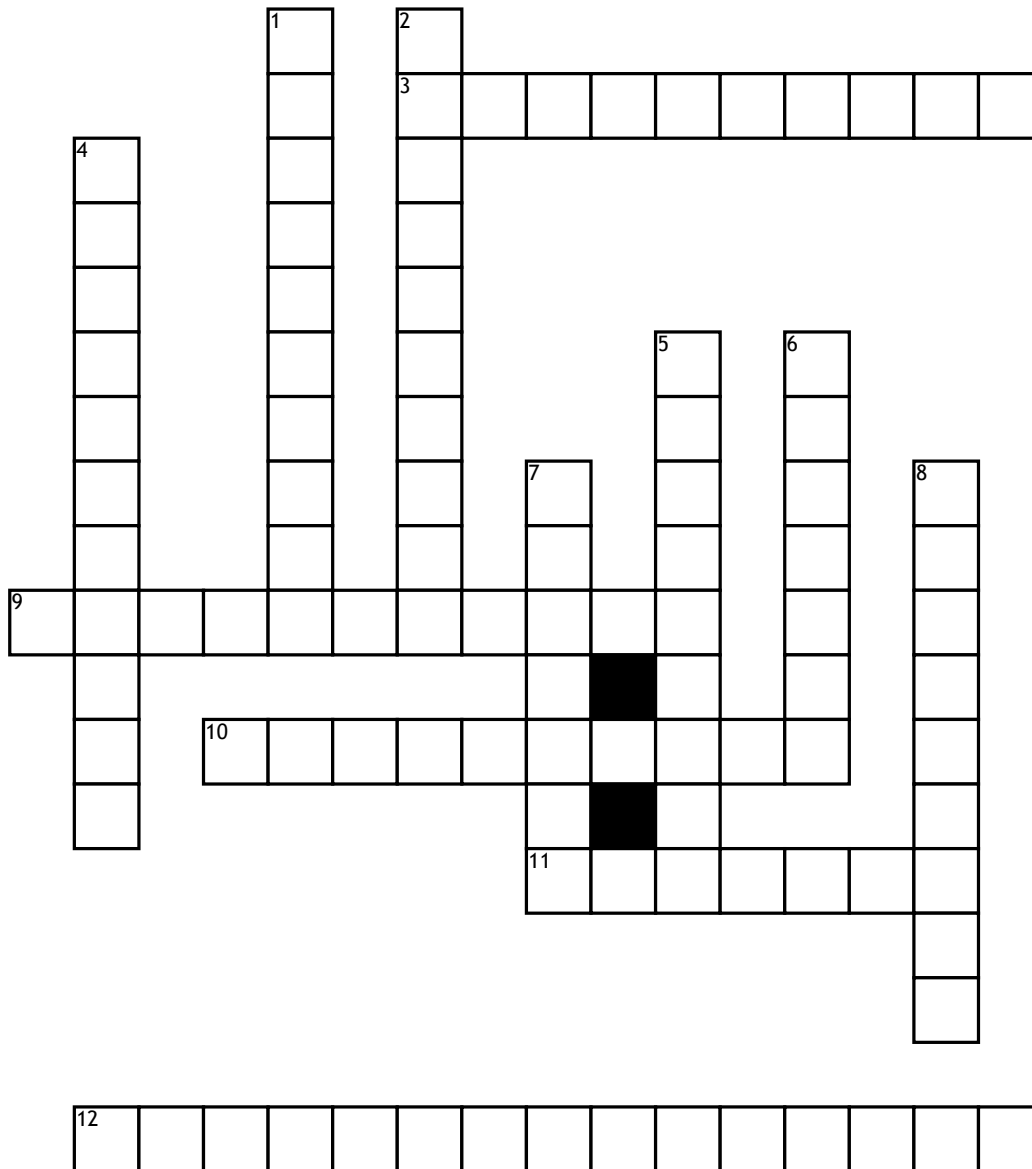


# 2.05 Respiratory System

**1.** An instrument for measuring the air capacity of the lungs

**2.** Inflammation of the lining of bronchial tubes, which carry air to and from the lungs

**4.** Small but continuous hemorrhage of the uterine mucous membrane

**5.** Infection that inflames air sacs in one or both lungs, which may fill with fluid

**6.** Deficiency in the amount of oxygen reaching the tissues

**7.** A large membranous tube reinforced by rings of cartilage, extending from the larynx to the bronchial tubes and conveying air to and from the lungs
