

- **2.** Infection that inflames air sacs in one or both lungs, which may fill with fluid

- 10. instrument for measuring and indicating temperature, typically one consisting of a narrow, hermetically sealed glass tube marked with graduations and having at one end a bulb containing mercury or alcohol that expands and contracts in the tube with heating and cooling.
- 11. large membranous tube reinforced by rings of cartilage, extending from the larynx to the bronchial tubes and conveying air to and from the lungs; the windpipe.
- **13.** removal of fluid from the abdomen by centesis
