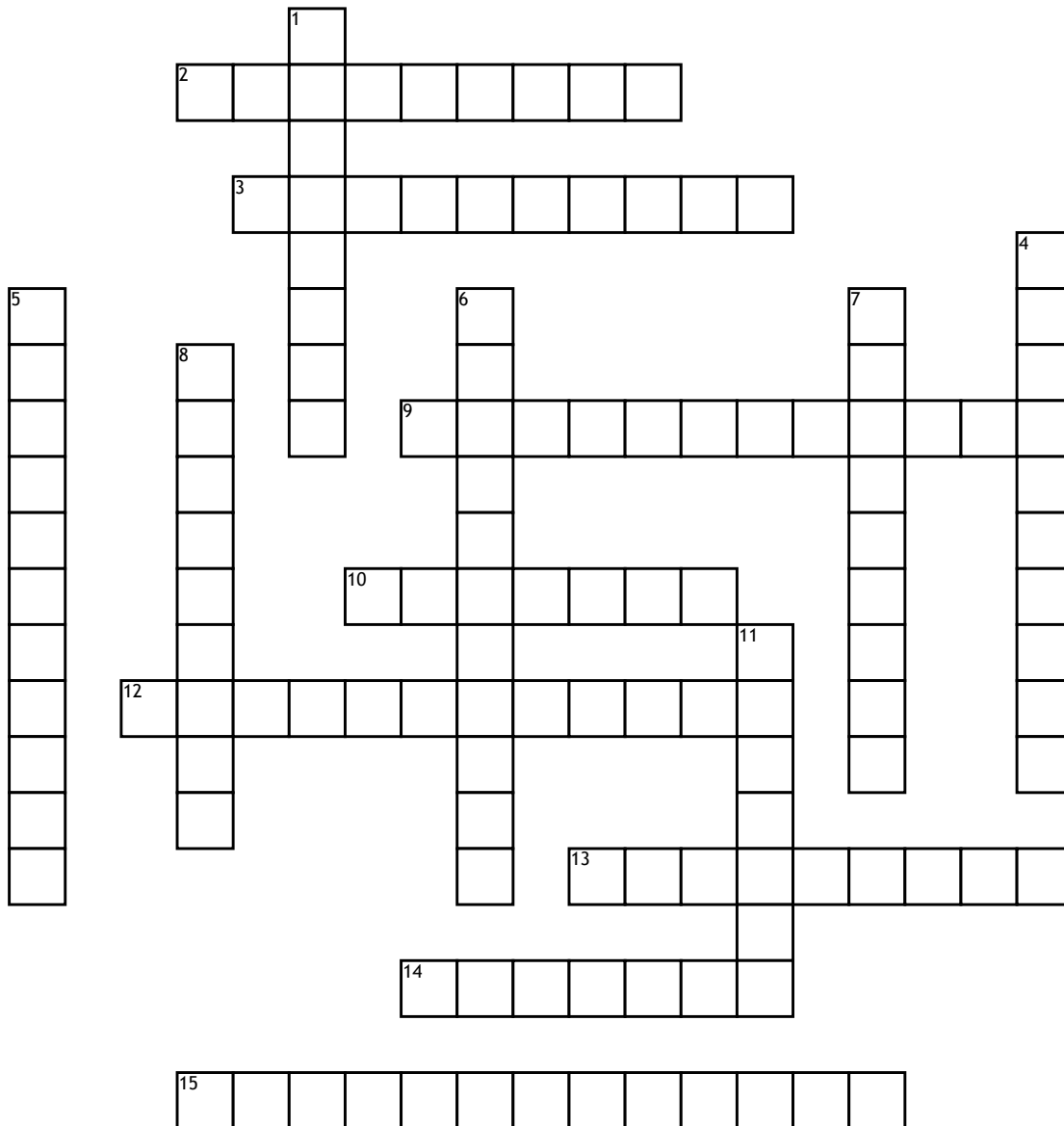

2. oozing of blood from the nose  
 3. inflammation of the lining of bronchial tubes, which carry air to and from the lungs  
 9. an apparatus used for recording and measuring spectra, especially as a method of analysis  
 10. a lower than normal concentration of oxygen in arterial blood  
 12. an examination that lets your doctor look at the back of your throat, your voice box, and vocal cords with a scope

13. excess drainage, ranging from a clear fluid to thick mucus, from the nose and nasal passage  
 14. a large membranous tube reinforced by rings of cartilage, extending from the larynx to the bronchial tubes and conveying air to and from the lungs, the windpipe  
 15. a procedure in which a needle is inserted into the pleural space between the lungs and the chest wall

1. a condition in which feces are discharged from the bowels frequently and in a liquid form

4. a common office test used to assess how well your lungs work by measuring how much air you inhale  
 5. an involuntary contraction of a muscle that can cause a great deal of pain  
 6. vibration of both the ventricular folds and the vocal folds, producing two simultaneous voice tones  
 7. inflammation of one or both lungs, with sensitive areas of lung inflammation  
 8. relating to the lungs
