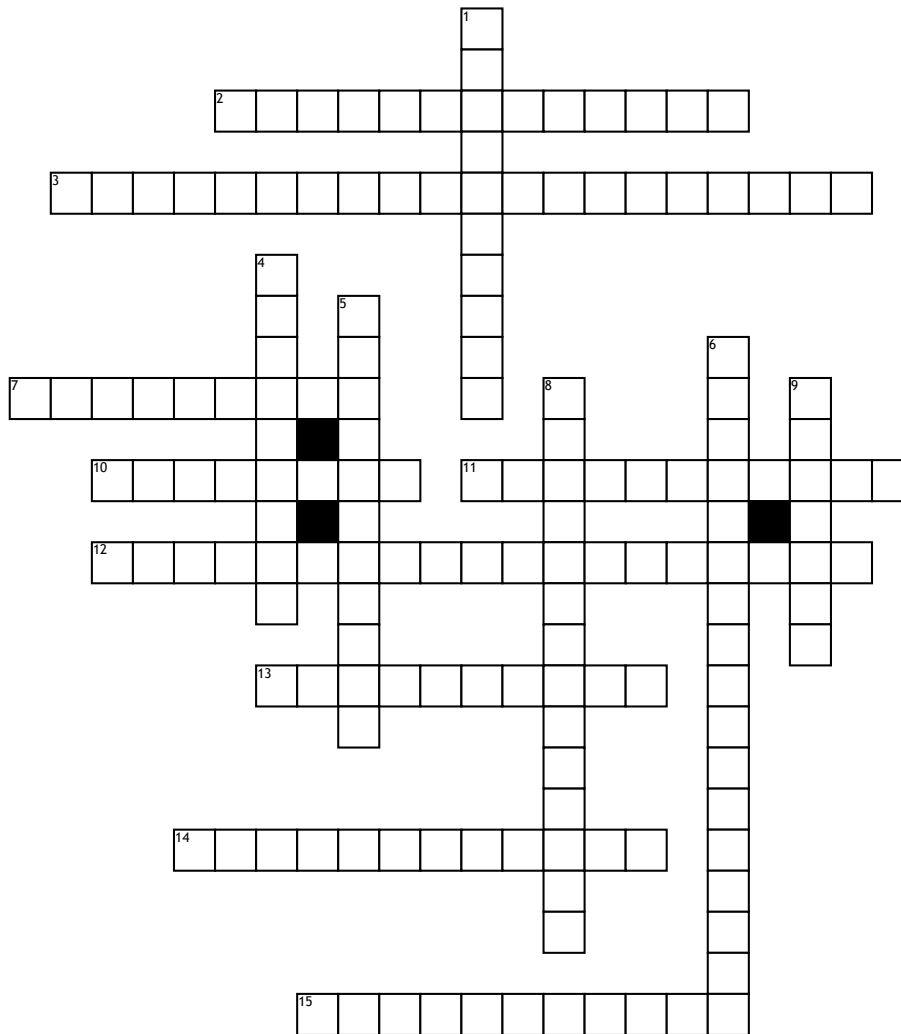


# 2.07 Medical Terminology

 3. lab test used to check stool samples for hidden (occult) blood

 11. forming teeth

12. gingival enlargement due to proliferation of fibrous connective tissue

13. Inflammation of the mucous lining of any of the structures in the mouth

14. Pinworm infection, an infection caused by a small, white intestinal worm

15. a procedure in which a flexible fiber-optic instrument is inserted through the anus in order to examine the colon

 5. process by which food is crushed and ground by teeth  
 6. removal of a band of tissue connecting the underside of the tongue with the floor of the mouth
