

- 9. Layer of the skin where new cells are made
- 10. Glands that release oils onto hairs

- 14. Layer of skin that attaches to muscle
- 15. Predominate tissue in the skin
- 16. Tissue with goblet cells

Down

- 1. Cells that create new bone
- 2. Vertebra with transverse foramen

- 4. Only freely moveable joint in the skull
- 6. Cells that breakdown bone
- 7. Tissue that forms tendons and ligaments
- 11. Spinal cord enters through this skull bone
- 12. Only bone not to articulate with any other
- 13. Cartilage on the ends of long bones
