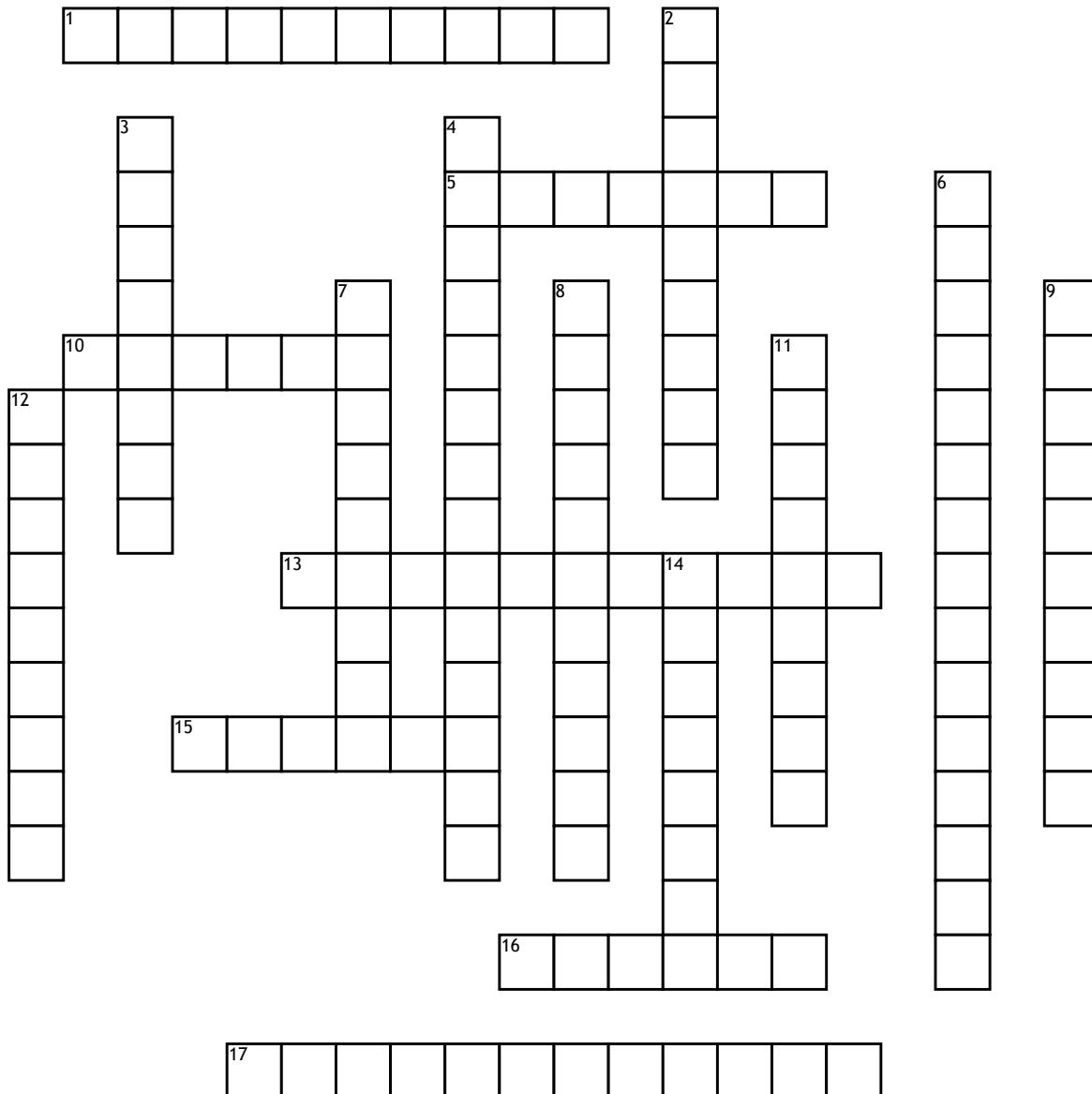


# 3.03 Sensory Medical Terminology
