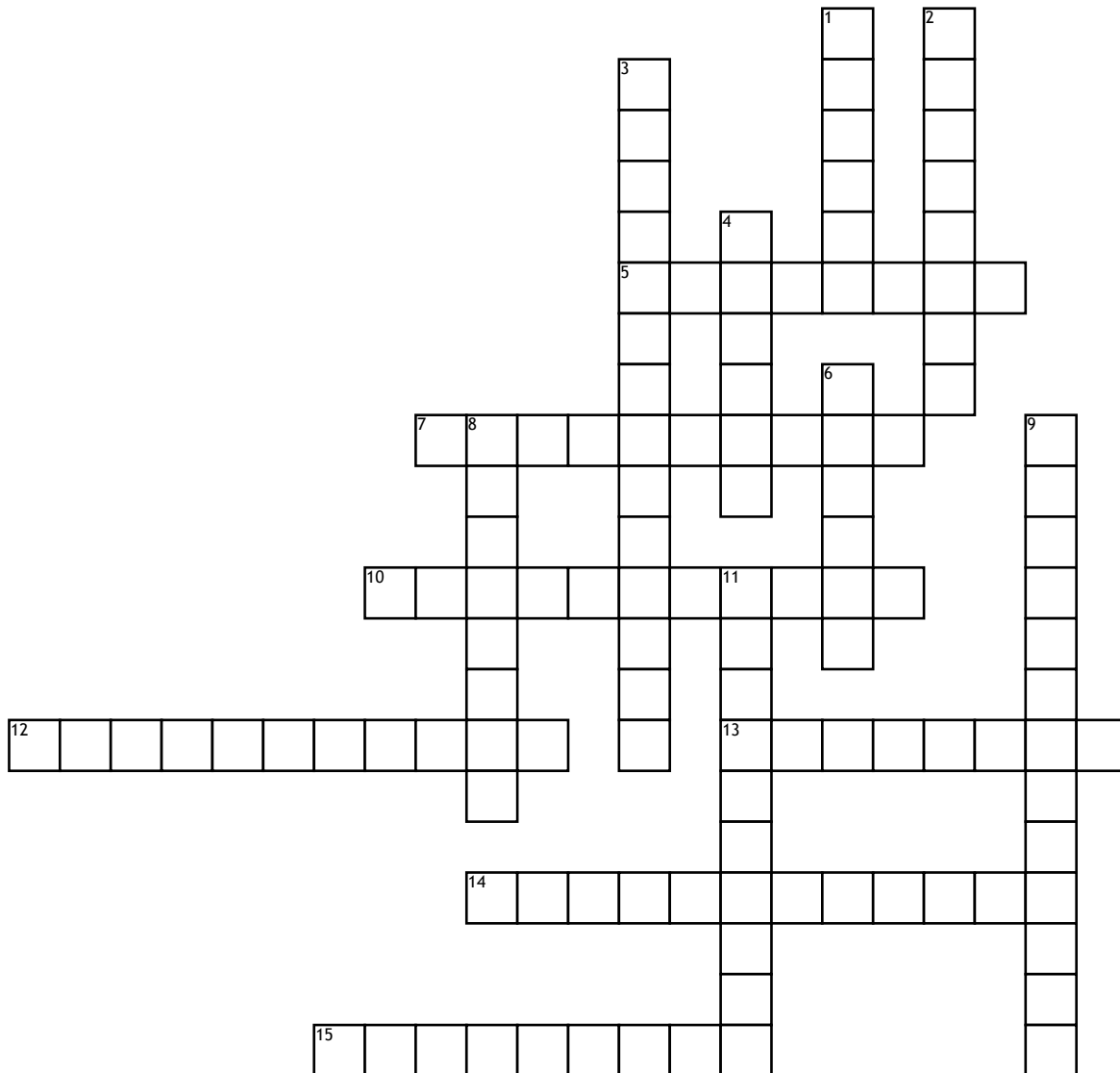

1. congenital disorder characterized by the complete or partial absence of pigment in the skin, hair and eyes

4. a band or sheet of connective tissue
