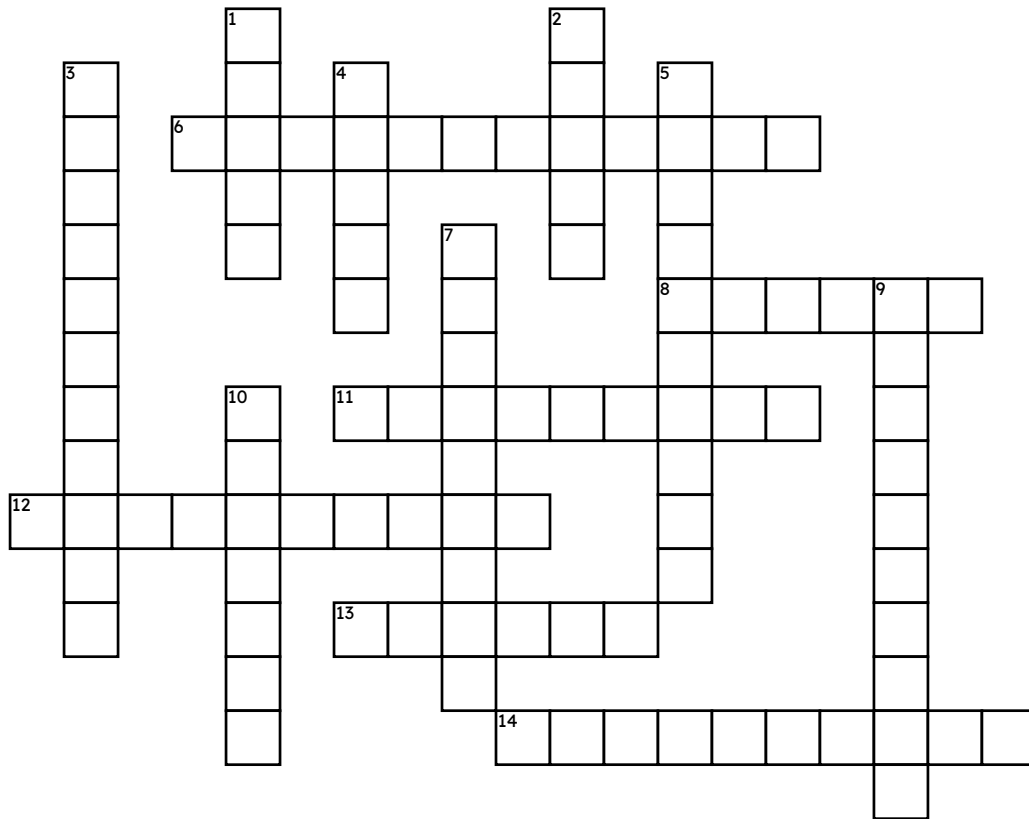


9.2 Water Erosion



Across

- 6.** a wide sloping deposit of sediment formed where a stream leaves a mountain range
8. water that moves over land and carries particles with it
11. a meander that has been cut off from the river
12. a deposit that hangs like an icicle from the roof of a cave
13. a small, narrow river

- 14.** builds up from the cave floor

Down

- 1.** a small stream, a shallow channel cut in the ground by running water
2. sediment deposited where a river flows into an ocean or lake builds up a land form
3. the term geologists use for underground water
4. a water-worn ravine

- 5.** may occur where a river meets an area of rock that is very hard and erodes slowly
7. a river stream flowing into a larger river or lake
9. flat, wide area along the river
10. loop-like bend in the course of a river
