

- **3.** Untitledbehaviors used by one person in a relationship to control the other. Partners may be married or not married; heterosexual, gay, or lesbian; living together, separated or dating.
- **4.** Follow you, show up wherever you are, monitor phone calls
- **5.** Doesn't allow access to financial resources; given an allowance

- **6.** The context of domestic violence that is potentially lethal form of assault
- 8. Distressing or upsetting event
- **9.** Prevents you from seeing family, friends or working
- **10.** Appear friendly & loving, often only abuse behind closed doors. They also try to hide the abuse by causing injuries that can be hidden and do not need a doctor.
