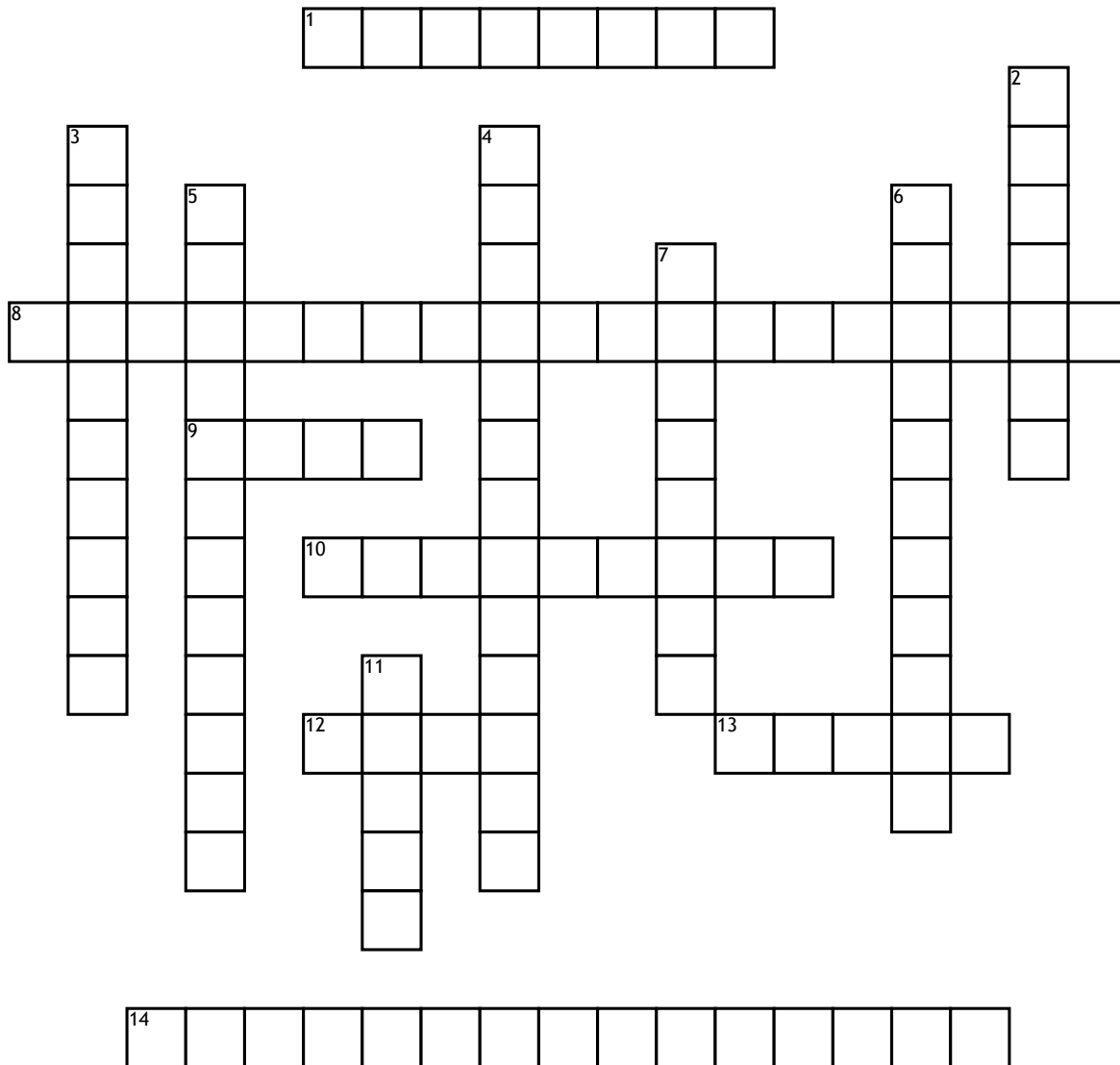

1. Won the Battle of Tsushima
 8. Promised free speech and elected assembly called the Duma
 9. An elected assembly who's agreement would be needed before any law could be passed
 10. A system of rule where one person holds total and supreme power
 12. Controlled the amount of land that each peasant farmed
 13. Played an important role in the October Revolution. Governed Russia from that point until his death

14. Asserted Nicholas II's full autocratic powers

2. councils set up by Alexander II to give peasants and urban workers some responsibility in local administration
 3. Him and his family were killed in 1918 by Bolsheviks
 4. Leading official at the beginning of the reign of Nicholas II, also a high ranking member of the Orthodox Church

5. A non-violent march that was attacked by Cossack soldiers. Russian people blamed the tsar for extreme reaction of the soldiers
 6. Emancipated the peasants, or serfs, in 1861
 7. Was founded, in 1893, to provide money for local communities and individual peasants to buy land
 11. Minister of Finance from 1892-1903, also one of the few officials in Nicholas II's government that supported reform
