

1. a boundary that lies along a longitude or latitude line or closely resembles one ex. France and Spain's shared boundary
4. A political and economic community (Contains 27 members)
5. a state that is broken up into several pieces that are not attached to each other ex any state with islands
6. A state that does not have a direct outlet to the sea
7. A state in which the distance from the center to any boundary does not vary significantly
8. A process by which a state breaks down through conflicts among it's ethnicities

9. moving or tending to move toward a center ex WW2 going in towards Germany on both sides
10. Granting of powers from the central gov of a state to national or regional gov
11. a country or area under the full or partial political control of another country, typically a distant one, and occupied by settlers from that country ex. America before it had independence
12. A state that encompasses a very small land area
16. A state whose territory corresponds to that occupied by a particular ethnicity that has been transformed into a nationality
17. An area organized into a political unit and ruled by an established government that has control over its internal and foreign affairs ex. Germany
