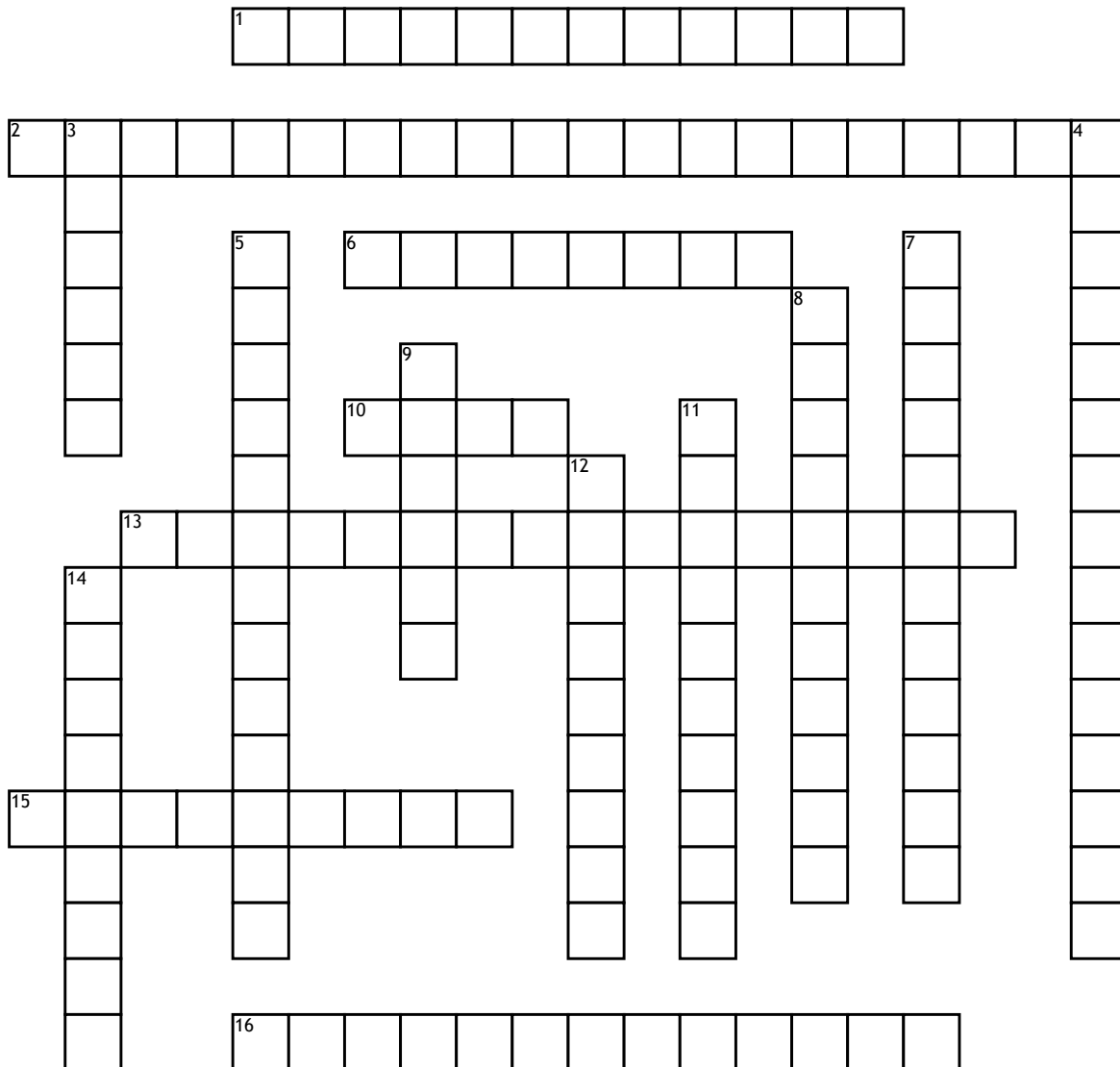

2. A practice primarily during the eighteenth century, in which European ships transported slaves from Africa to Caribbean islands, molasses from the Caribbean to Europe, and trade goods from Europe to Africa.

6. The mass killing of a group of people in attempt to eliminate the entire group from existence.

10. Identity with a group of people that share legal attachment and personal allegiance to a particular place.

13. An attitude that tends to unify people and enhance support for a state.

15. Identity with a group of people who share the cultural traditions of a particular homeland or hearth.

16. A place with a high concentration of an ethnic group that is distinct from those in the surrounding area.

3. A person who subscribes to the beliefs of racism.

4. A purposeful policy designed by one ethnic or religious group to remove by violent and terror-inspiring means the civilian population of another ethnic or religious group from certain geographic areas.

5. A process by which a state breaks down through conflicts among its ethnicities.

7. A person who works fields rented from a landowner and pays the rent and repays loans by turning over to the landowner a share of the crops.

8. A strong feeling of pride in and devotion to one's country.

9. Belief that race is the primary determinant of human traits and capacities and that racial differences produce an inherent superiority of a particular race.

11. A small geographic area that cannot successfully be organized into stable countries because it is inhabited by many ethnicities with complex, long-standing antagonism toward each other

12. A suburban area with a cluster of a particular ethnic population.

14. Laws (no longer in effect) in South Africa that physically separated different races into different geographic areas.
