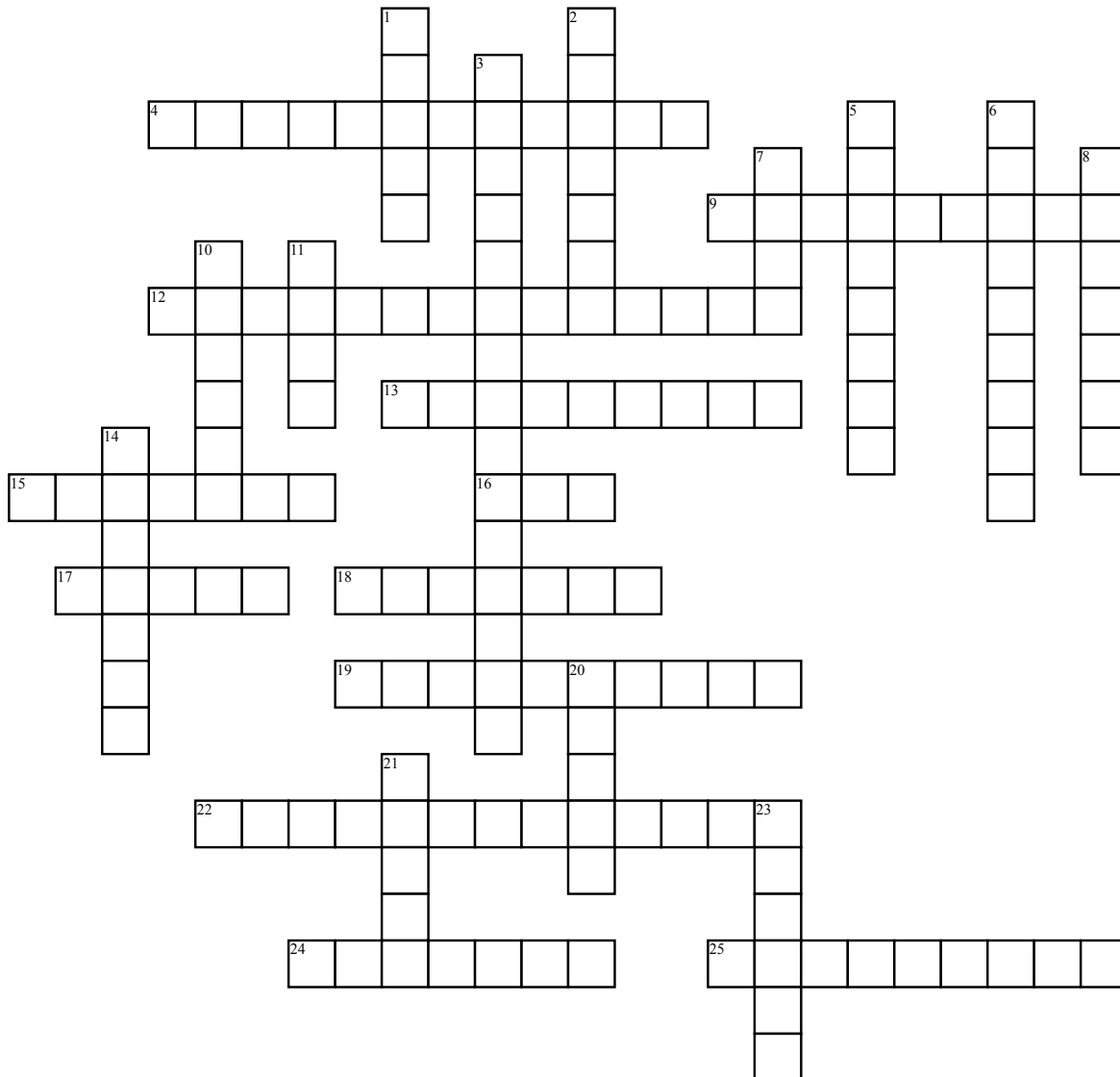

4. An advanced state of human society that have a surplus of food, thus allowing a division of labor. Includes social hierarchies, political organization, merchants and manufacturing groups.

9. The Epic of \_\_\_\_\_ is a Mesopotamian epic poem dating back to 2000 BCE. The poem details the story of a Sumerian king and is one of the oldest surviving pieces of human literature.

12. It was a historically important city due to its location, which made it a major center of trade between Europe and Asia and a major cultural and artistic center. This city later fell during the Crusades.

13. The \_\_\_\_\_ Revolution started in about 10,000 BCE when humans began to cultivate crops and domesticate certain animals. This was a change from the system of hunting and gathering that had sustained humans from earliest times.

15. The Era of \_\_\_\_\_ States is the period of social unrest and fight for the throne of China following the Zhou dynasty. The Qin dynasty took power and implemented a system of legalism to end it.

16. From between 202 B.C.E to 200 C.E., this dynasty was founded when the Qin dynasty ended. They reasserted Confucian ideas repressed during Qin Dynasty and expanded the bureaucracy. Eventually fell due to Hun invasion.

17. The \_\_\_\_\_ Rebellion started in 1989 but was not officially put down until 1901 and was led by the Righteous and Harmonious Fists

18. The \_\_\_\_\_ Empire was a Muslim gunpowder empire founded in the early 16th century that practiced Shi'a Islam

19. A result of Enlightenment thinking and the Industrial Revolution that declares government should exist in a limited form, with the consent of the governed, to protect the rights of men, and to guarantee the political equality of all men

24. He is considered the first caliph, or religious and political leader. He was also the immediate successor to Muhammad and was able to put down revolts by various Arab tribes and false prophets during what are known as the Ridda Wars.
