

- **5.** Risk factors include: depression, substance use, having access to a firearm, and intimate partner issues
- 8. Can face barriers to adequate health care, can have increased risk for psychological distress and substance use disorders (abbreviation)
- **9.** Long Term exposure is related to cancer, reproductive problems, Parkinson's disease, liver damage and behavioral issues
- 10. Includes failure to provide physical care, emotional care, education, health or dental care
- 1. Failure to provide for the needs of a vulnerable person when adequate funds are available

- **2.** Limited education and job opportunities, increased risk for poverty and homelessness, increased risk of school problems
- **3.** Indicates a factor in the body, senses, or mind that affects the way a person interacts in the daily environment
- **4.** Forced to leave place of origin due to disaster, war, or threatening environment
- **6.** Irritability, tremors, nausea, vomiting, headaches, diaphoresis, anxiety, sleep disturbances, tachycardia, elevated BP
- 7. The primary indication of dependence
