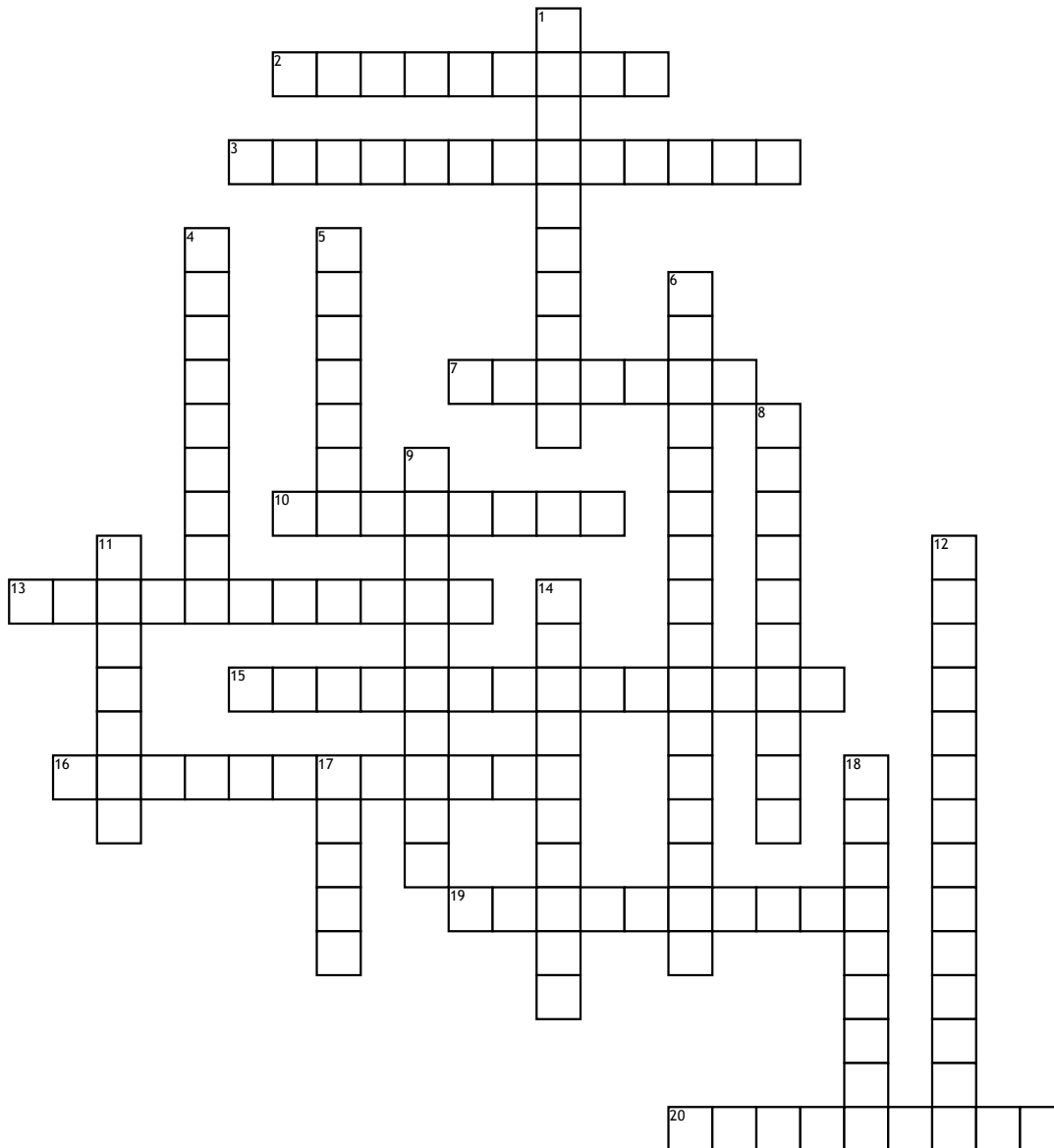


# A Civil War Crossword



## Across

2. Supreme Court's ruling in the \_\_\_\_\_ case (1857) confirmed the legality of slavery in the territories
3. Sherman outmaneuvered Confederate forces to take Atlanta by September, after which he and some 60,000 Union troops began the famous "\_\_\_\_\_", devastating Georgia on the way to capturing Savannah on December 21
7. Exhausted by the Union siege of Petersburg and Richmond, Lee's forces made a last attempt at resistance, attacking and captured the Federal-controlled Fort \_\_\_\_\_ on March 25
10. Lincoln had used the occasion of the Union victory at \_\_\_\_\_ to issue a preliminary Emancipation Proclamation, which freed all enslaved people in the rebellious states after January 1, 1863.
13. Battle of Gettysburg, in which Union General \_\_\_\_\_ defeated Confederate General Robert E. Lee, bringing an end to the Confederacy's Northern invasion, as well as Lincoln's famous Gettysburg Address.
