

12. federal reconstruction agency that provided food and built schools and hospitals; first program to provide public schools for either Black or white children in Georgia

13. Missouri slave who sued owner for freedom because he lived in free territory; was denied the right to sue by the Supreme Court

14. proclamation made by President Lincoln on January 1, 1863 that declared all slaves in the rebellious states free

15. established Georgia's conditional acceptance of the Compromise of 1850 and kept Georgia from seceding from the Union

1. a legal idea that a state has the right to cancel any law they deem unconstitutional

2. the belief that a state's interests should take priority over the federal government's interests

4. legislation passed in which California was admitted as a free state and a stronger Fugitive Slave Act was passed

5. battle of largest Union defeat; led to General Sherman's victorious Atlanta campaign

6. a destructive path of total war from Atlanta to Savannah

7. Abraham Lincoln was elected as president, led to southern states seceding from Union

8. one of the most important strategies of the Civil War; designed to keep the South from trading cotton with foreign countries in return for weapons and other supplies

11. the period immediately after the Civil War when Southern states rebuilt and rejoined the Union
