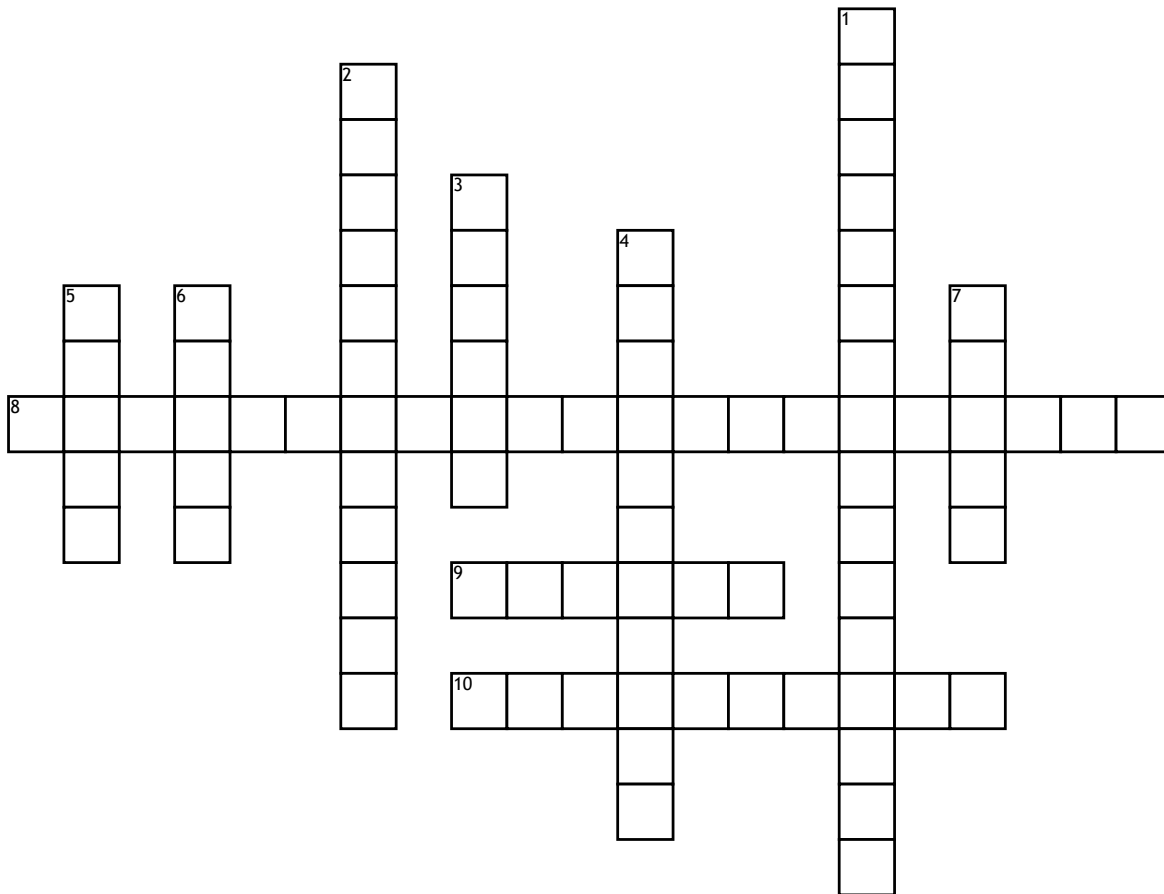

7. a usually carved or painted representation of objects serving as the emblem of a family/clan. It is often a reminder of its ancestry
