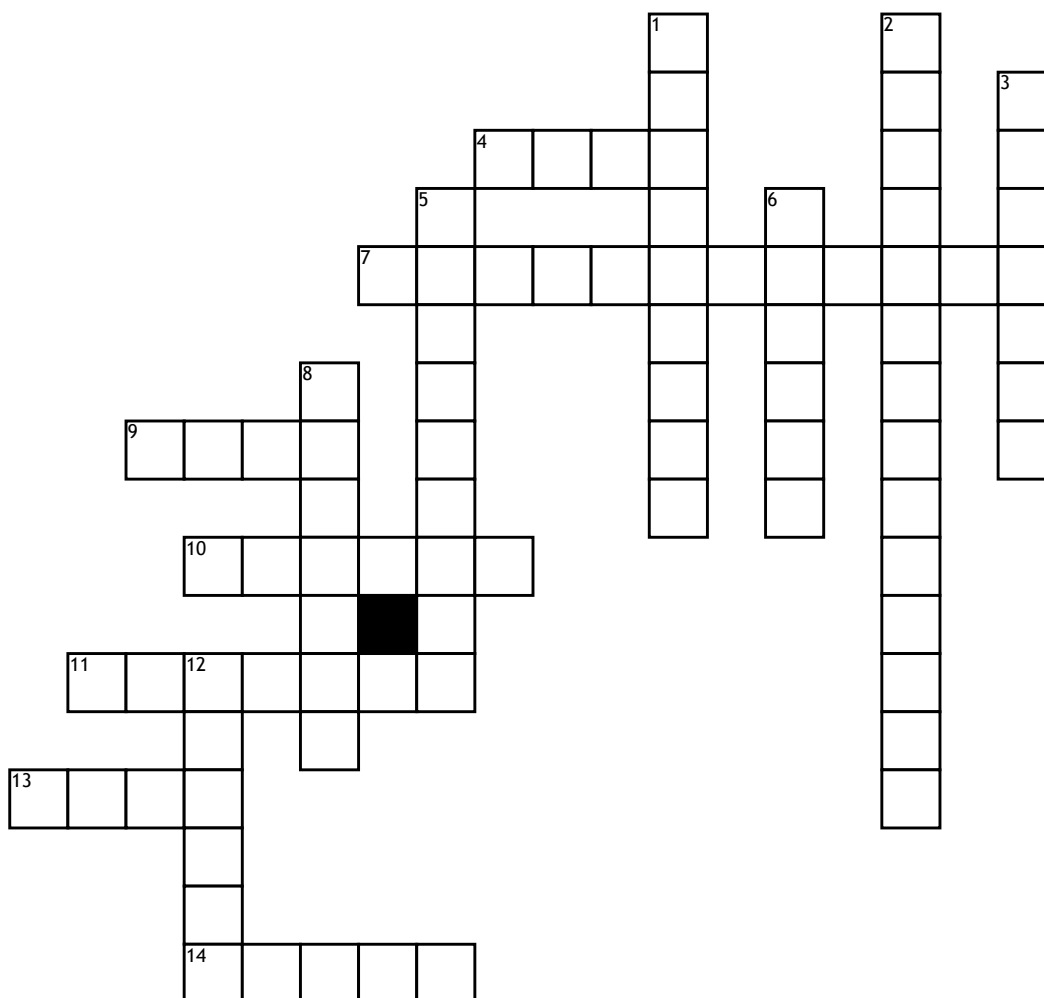


Acids and alkalis crossword
