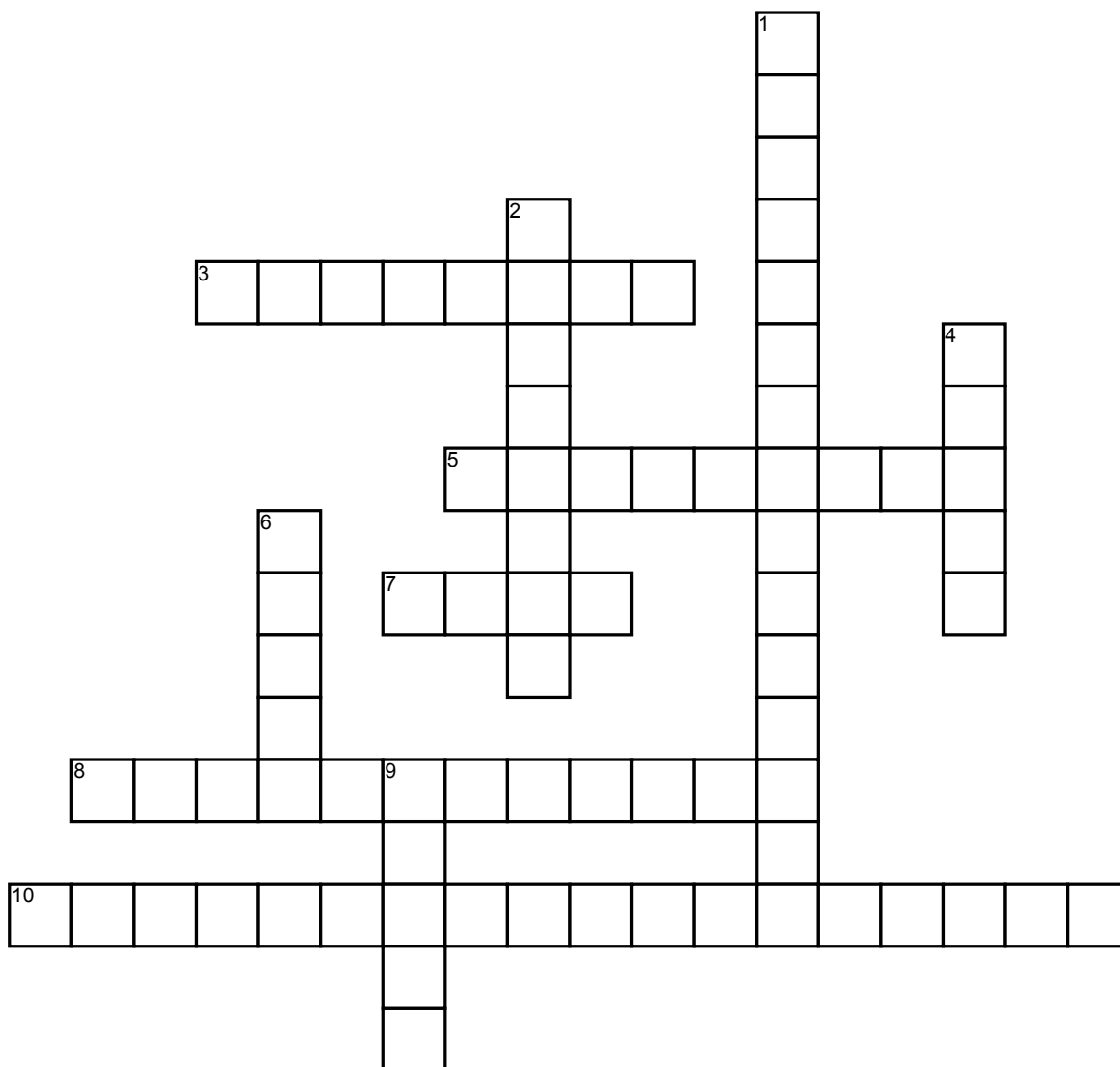

- 3.** a blood protein produced in response to and counteracting a specific antigen. Antibodies combine chemically with substances that the body recognizes as alien, such as bacteria, viruses, and foreign substances in the blood
- 5.** a type of cell within the body capable of engulfing and absorbing bacteria and other small cells and particles
- 7.** the thin layer of tissue forming the natural outer covering of the body of a person or animal
- 8.** a localized physical condition in which part of the body becomes reddened, swollen, hot, and often painful, especially as a reaction to injury or infection
