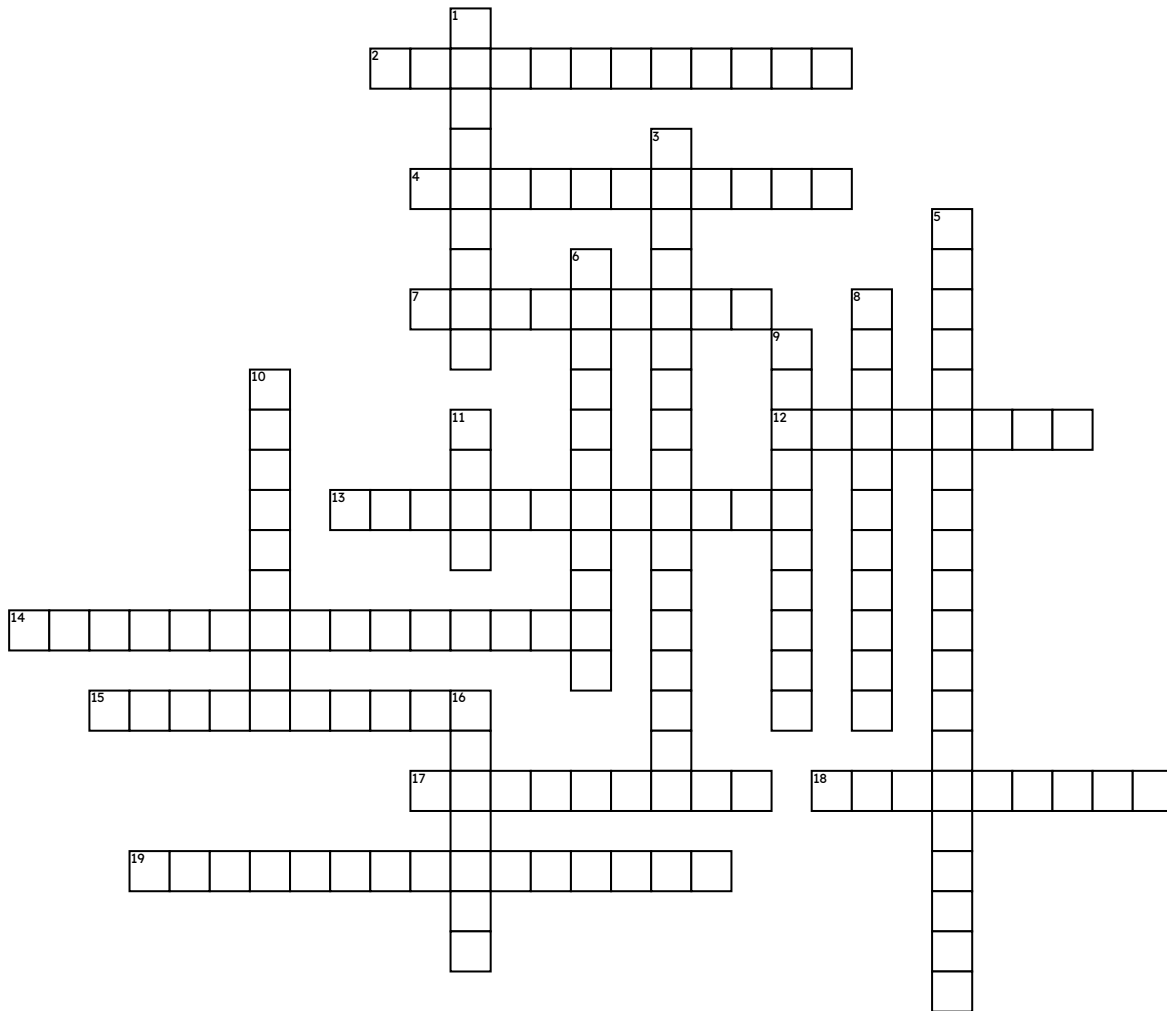


# Adams, Jefferson, and The War of 1812
