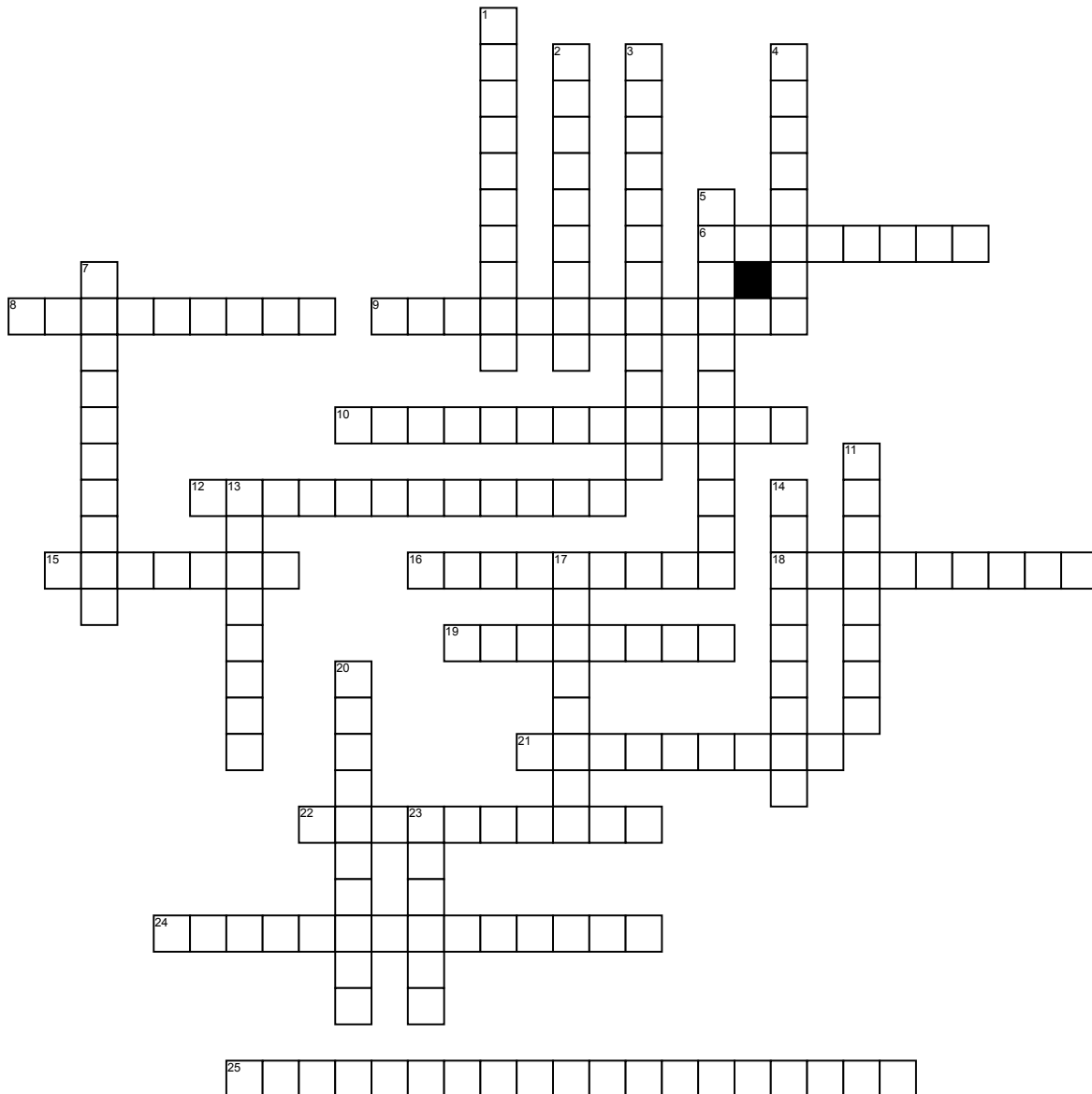

- 8. a preconceived opinion that is not based on reason or actual experience
- 9. focusing on European culture or history to the exclusion of a wider view of the world; implicitly regarding European culture as preeminent
- 10. the sea journey undertaken by slave ships from West Africa to the West Indies
- 12. the theory of knowledge, especially with regard to its methods, validity, and scope
- 15. intolerance toward those who hold different opinions from oneself
- 16. the fact or state of belonging to a social group that has a common national or cultural tradition
- 18. the science of the origin and development of the universe
- 19. leadership or dominance, especially by one country or social group over others

- 21. a political theory derived from Karl Marx, advocating class war and leading to a society in which all property is publicly owned and each person works and is paid according to their abilities and needs
