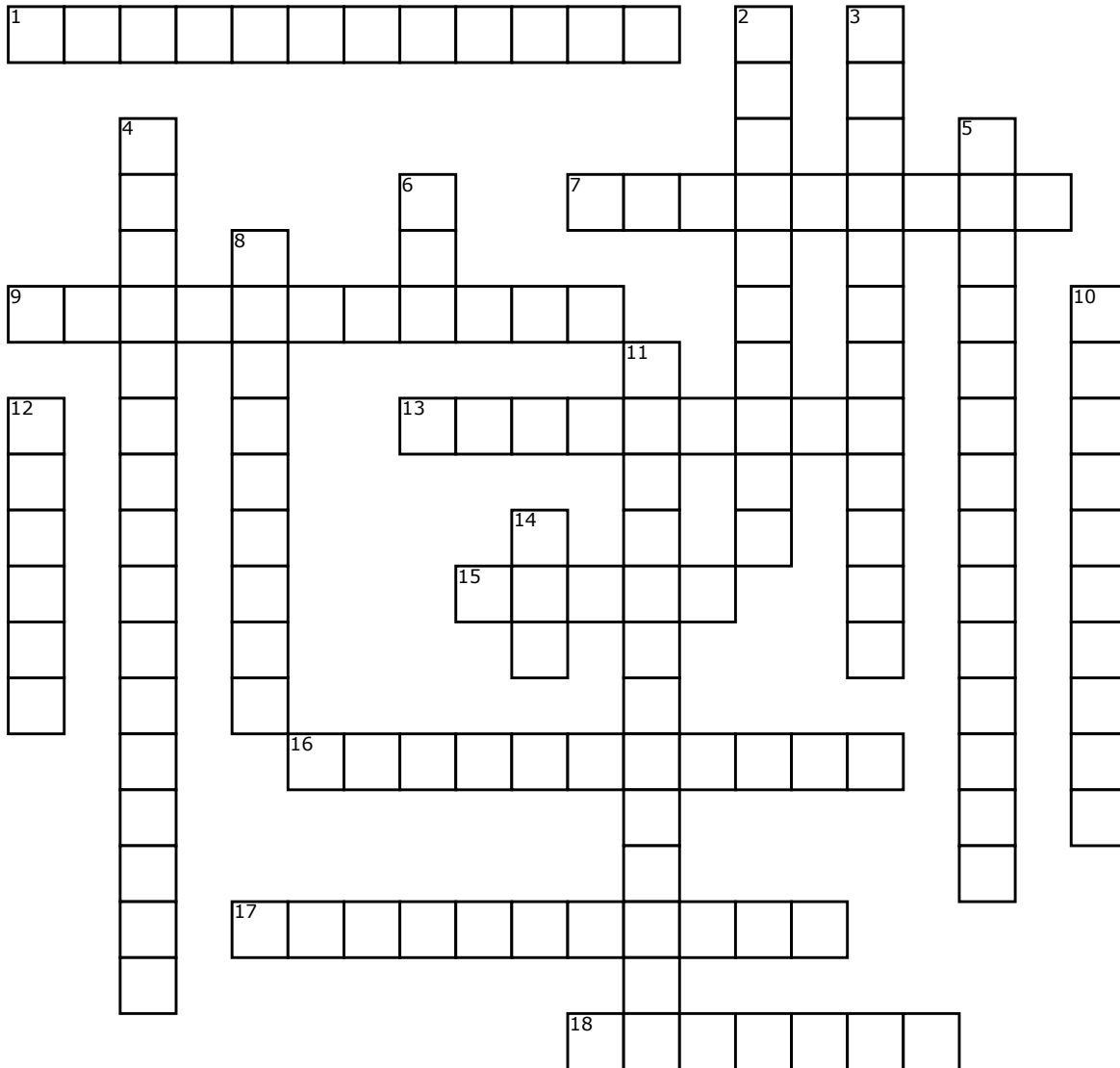

- 7.** A body part or condition that appears on both sides of the midline
- 9.** Occasional, gasping breaths that occur after the heart has stopped
- 13.** A process of which molecules move from an area of higher concentration to lower concentration
- 15.** Absence of spontaneous breathing

16. Subdivision of the smaller bronchi in the lungs

17. The process of exchanging oxygen and carbon dioxide

18. A dangerous condition in which the body cells and tissues do not have enough oxygen

3. Nerve that innervates the diaphragm

4. a side lying position used to maintain a clear airway in unconscious patients without injuries who are breathing adequately

5. Thin membrane that lines the chest cavity

6. Airway adjunct inserted into the nose

8. A normal reflex mechanism that causes retching

10. The active, muscular part of breathing

11. An assessment tool that measures oxygen saturation of hemoglobin in the capillary beds

12. point at which the trachea bifurcates (divides) into left and right

14. Airway adjunct inserted into the mouth
