

- **9.** Occasional, gasping breaths that occur after the heart has stopped
- **13.** A process of which molecules move from an area of higher concentration to lower concentration
- **15.** Absence of spontaneous breathing

- **16.** Subdivision of the smaller bronchi in the lungs
- **17.** The process of exchanging oxygen and carbon dioxide
- **18.** A dangerous condition in which the body cells and tissues do not have enough oxygen

- **3.** Nerve that innervates the diaphragm
- **4.** a side lying position used to maintain a clear airway in unconscious patients without injuries who are breathing adequately
