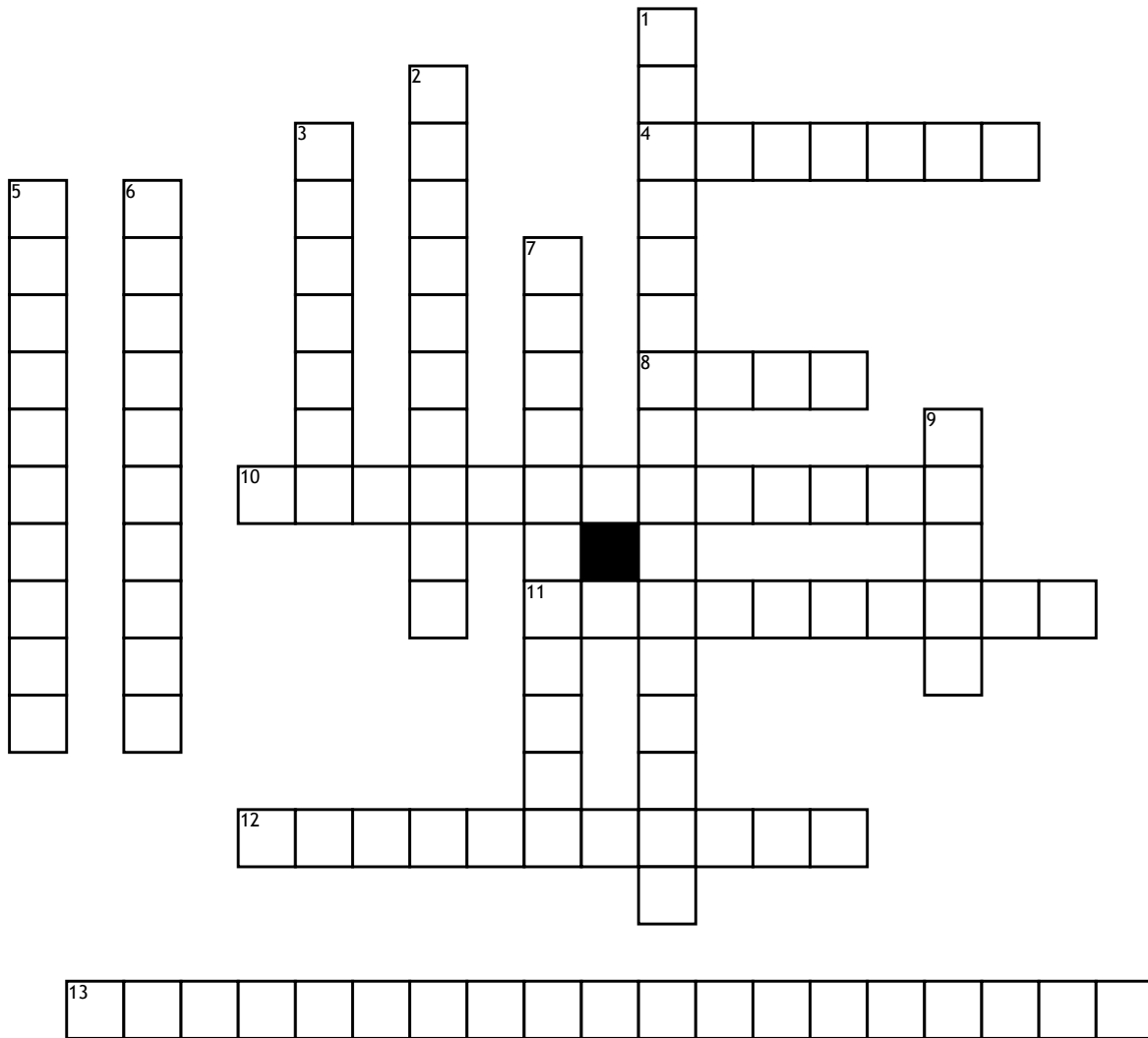


Alcohol Consumption Crossword
