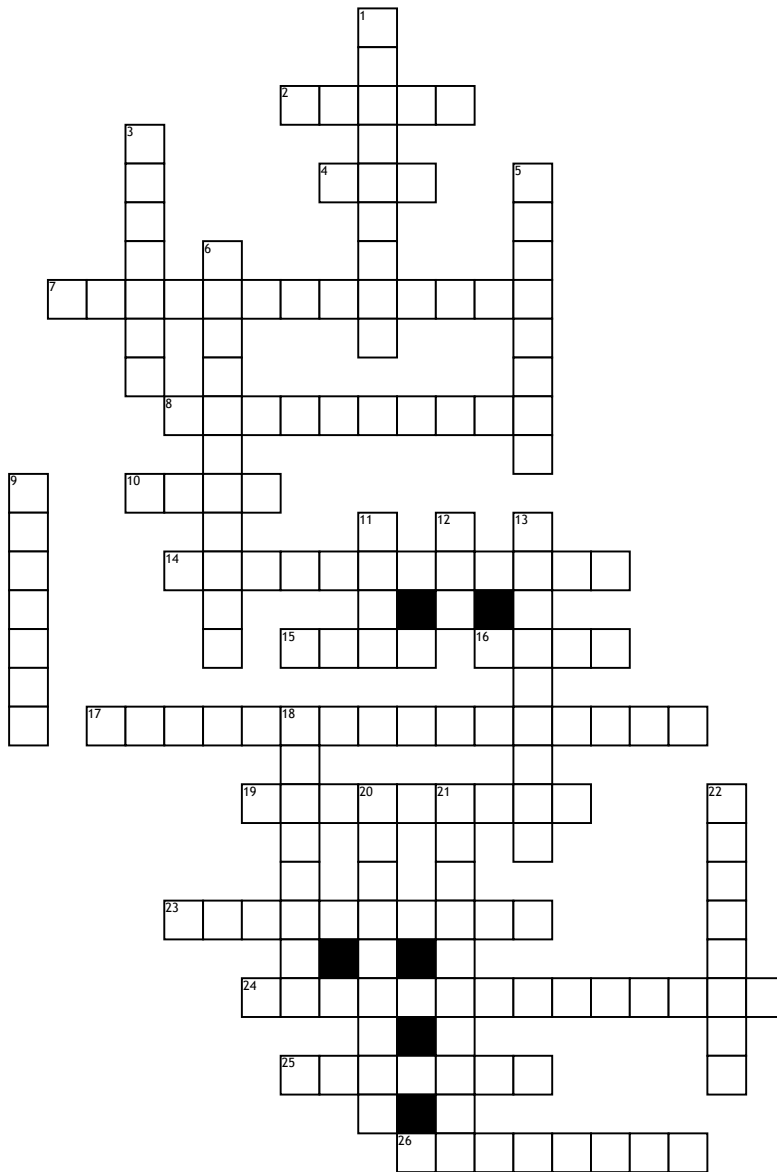


Alcohol Crossword Puzzle
