

1. Mixes food with gastric juices, limited absorption

- **2.** Helps move food through stomach into intestines
- **3.** Ring of contractions that make a wavelike motion to move food
- **4.** This peritoneal membrane suspends portions of the small intestine from the posterior abdominal wall
- **6.** Contains enzymes that breakdown carbohydrates
- **8.** This type of food passes through the stomach in 3-6 hours
