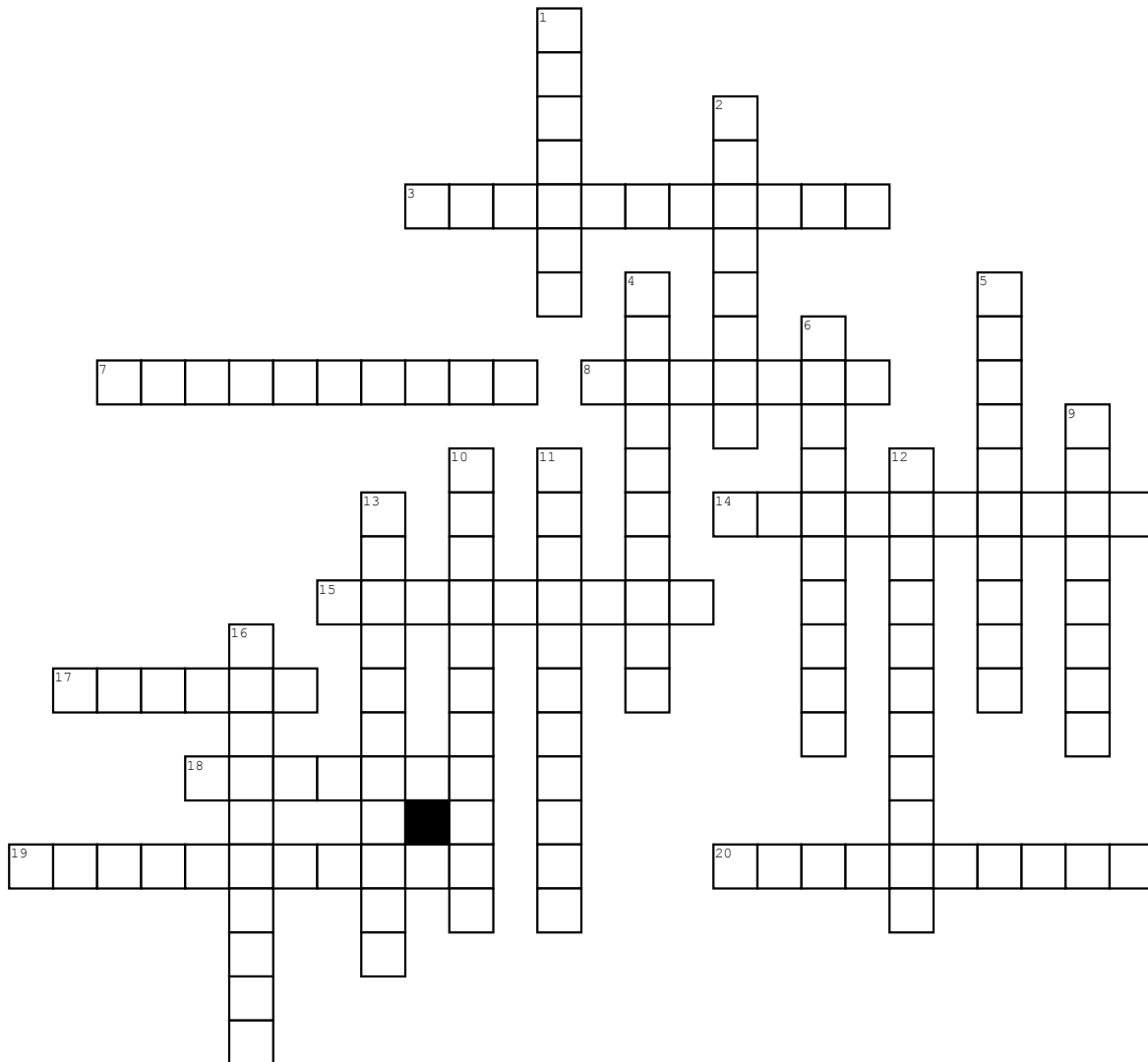


All The Bright Places Crossword Puzzle
