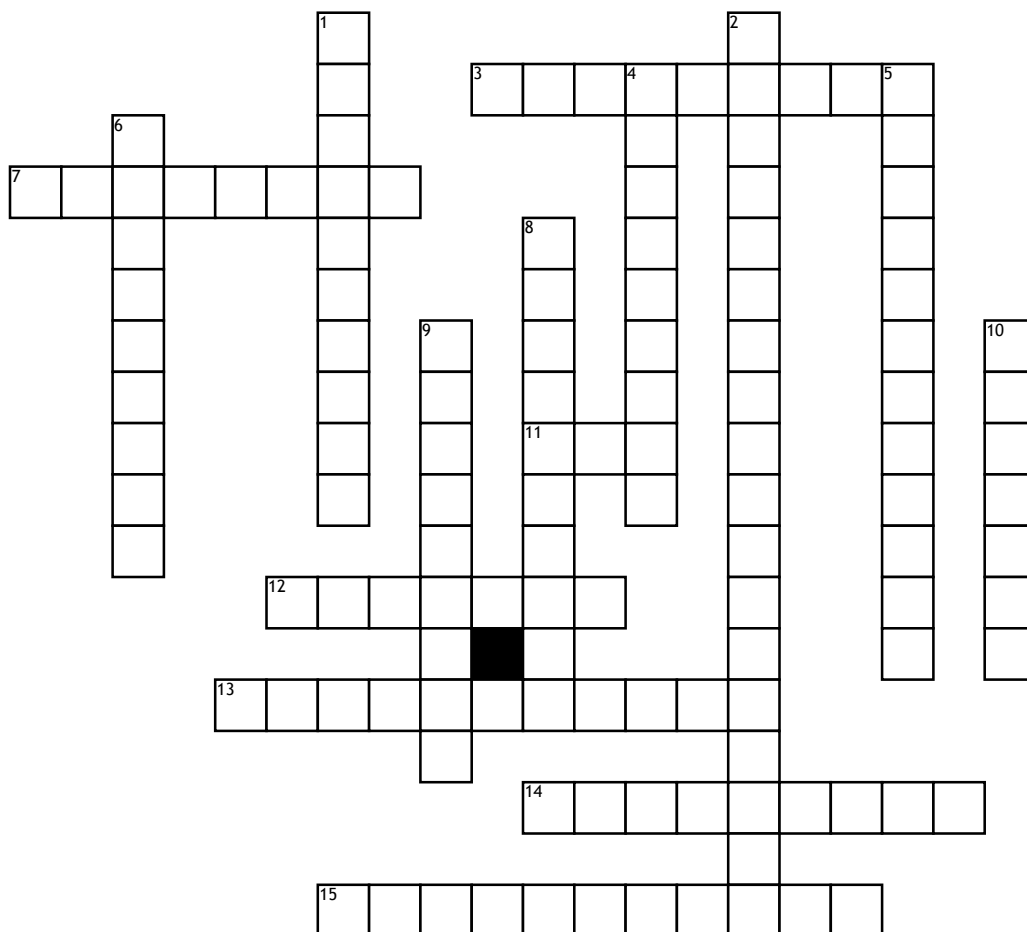

3. downward moving air associated with falling precipitation

 13. floods that arise rapidly with little or no advance warning, usually brought about by thunderstorms precipitation

1. rapid rise in water level along the coast as a hurricane or tropical storm approaches  
 2. storm that becomes an intense center off low pressure that can potentially become a hurricane  
 4. a type of storm along the east coast named for where the winds come from  
 5. Type of severe weather that is composed of one or more cells that brings heavy precipitation and strong gusty winds

6. a discharge of electricity from a thundercloud to the ground to another cloud or to another spot within the cloud itself

8. a very large single cell thunderstorm with particularly strong updrafts

9. a slide of large masses of snow down a mountain

10. the region of upward motion responsible for building the cloud
