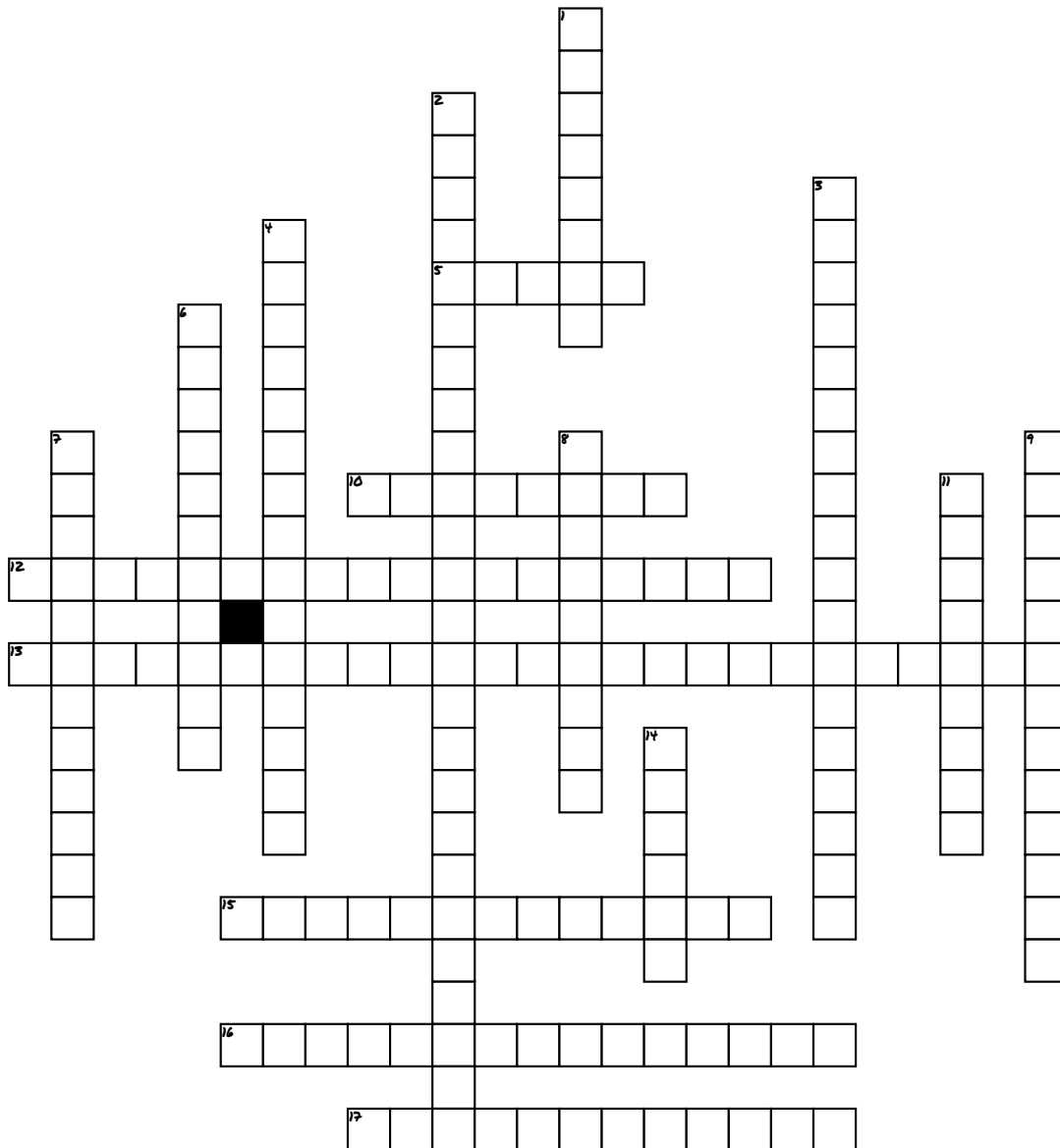

1. PASSED BY THE BRITISH PARLIAMENT ON MARCH 22, 1765.
