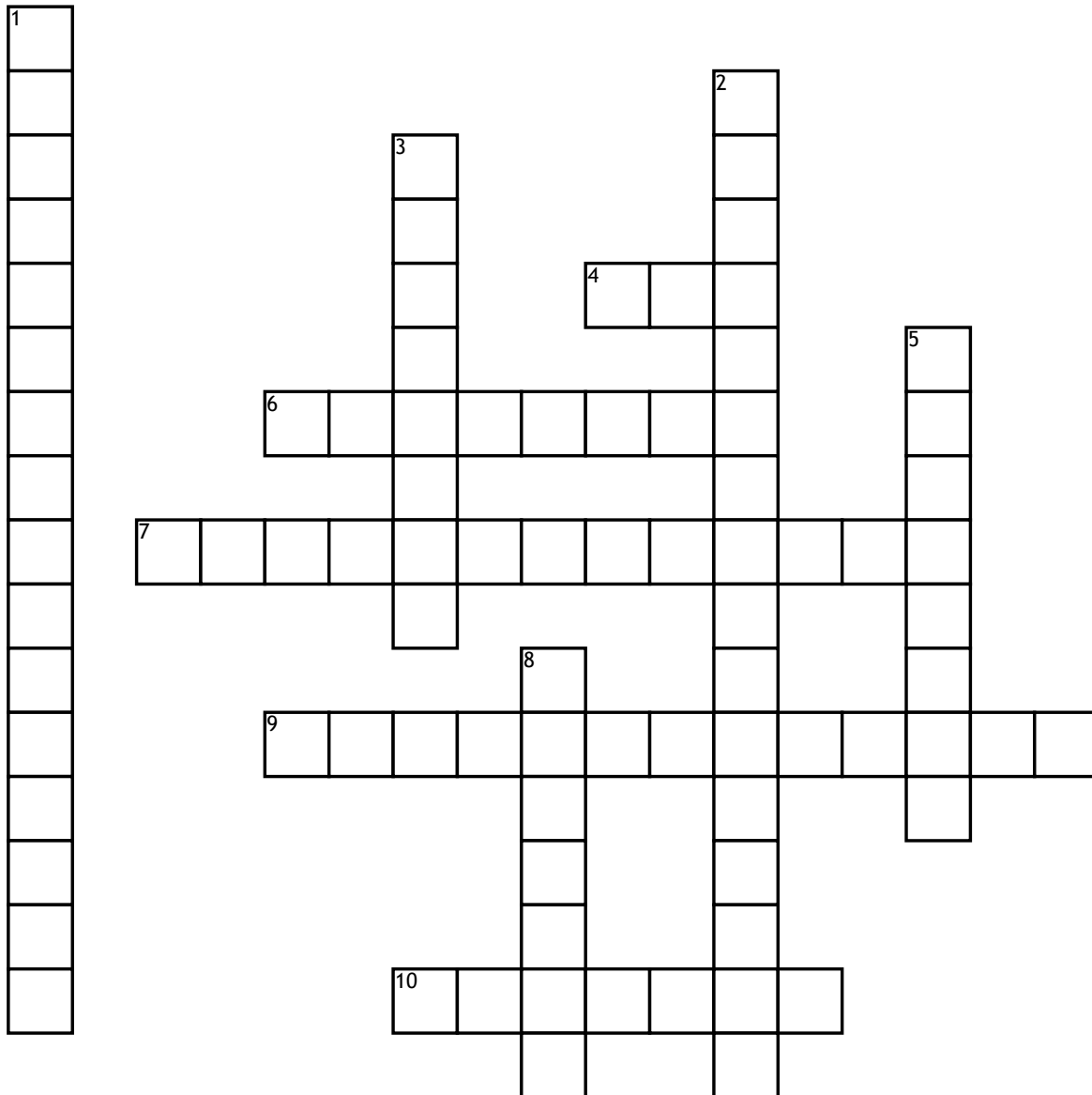


# American revolution
