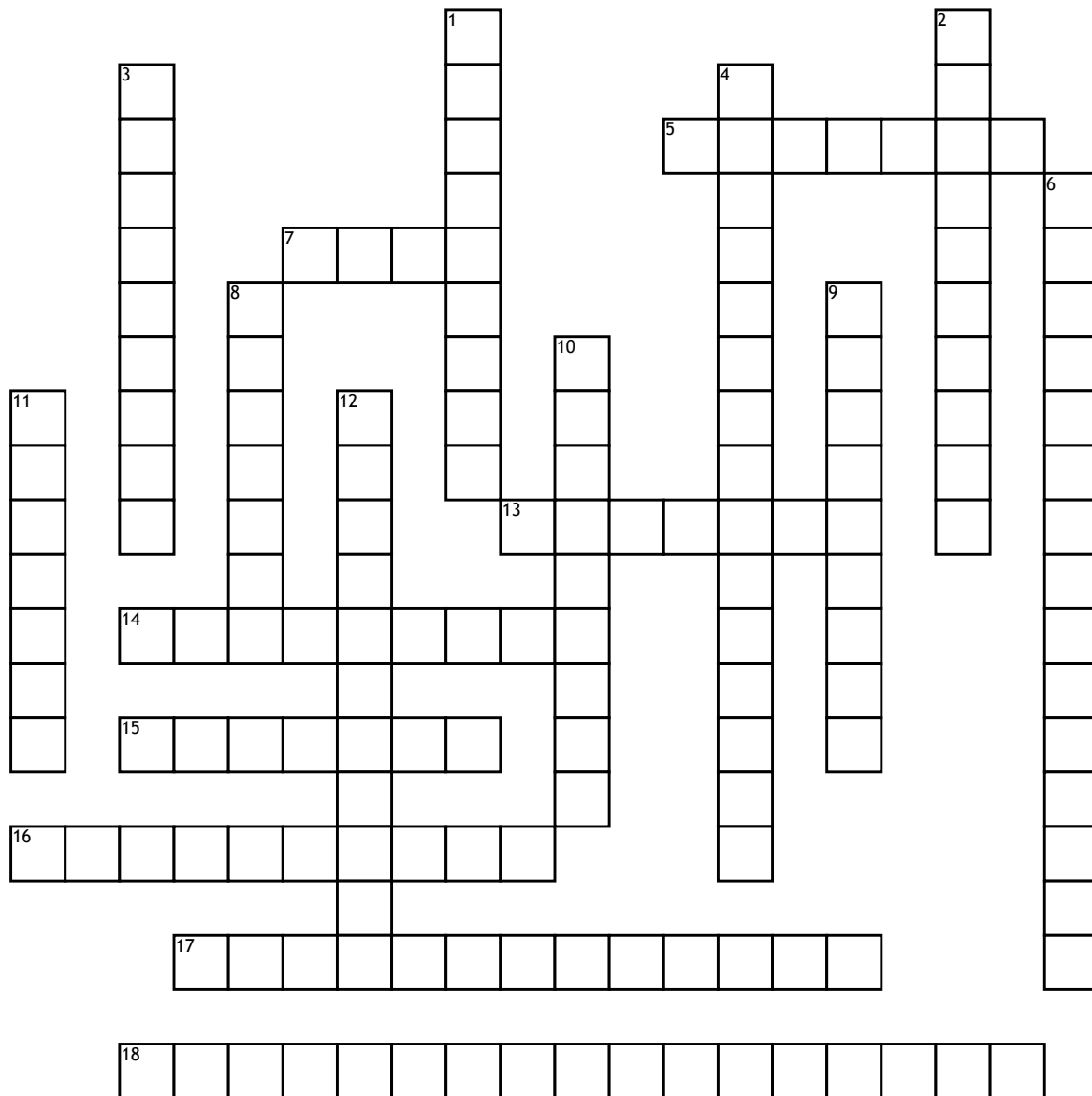


# Anatomy 341 Lab 5 ~ Gross Musculoskeletal Anatomy of Upper Limb

5. muscle that originates at clavicle and inserts at deltoid tuberosity on shaft of humerus

7. bone that is medial in the forearm
