

- **3.** area of the mesial and distal tooth surface that touch each other
- 4. lower jaw
- **5.** The space between the proximal surfaces

- 7. is the tooth bearing part of the jaw.
- **8.** the bone that surrounds & supports each individual tooth socket
- **9.** curving structure formed by the teeth in their normal position.
