

- 2. Has three flaps that open and close, allowing blood to flow from RA to RV
- **6.** Receives oxygenated blood from the lungs and pumps it down to LV
- **9.** It is the thickest chambers and responsible for pumping oxygenated blood to the tissue all over the body
- **10.** Carries blood from the head, neck, arms and chest

Down

1. Are blood vessels that transfer freshly oxygenated blood from the Left Atrium

- **3.** It separates the LA from the LV; it prevents the blood flowing backward
- **4.** It transport deoxygenated blood from the right side of the heart to the lungs for oxygenation
- **5.** Carries blood from the lower extremities, abdomen and pelvis
- 7. Is the main Pulmonary Artery
- **8.** It is the first chamber to receive deoxygenated blood
- **11.** Is the main Artery that carries oxygenated blood to the different parts of our body
