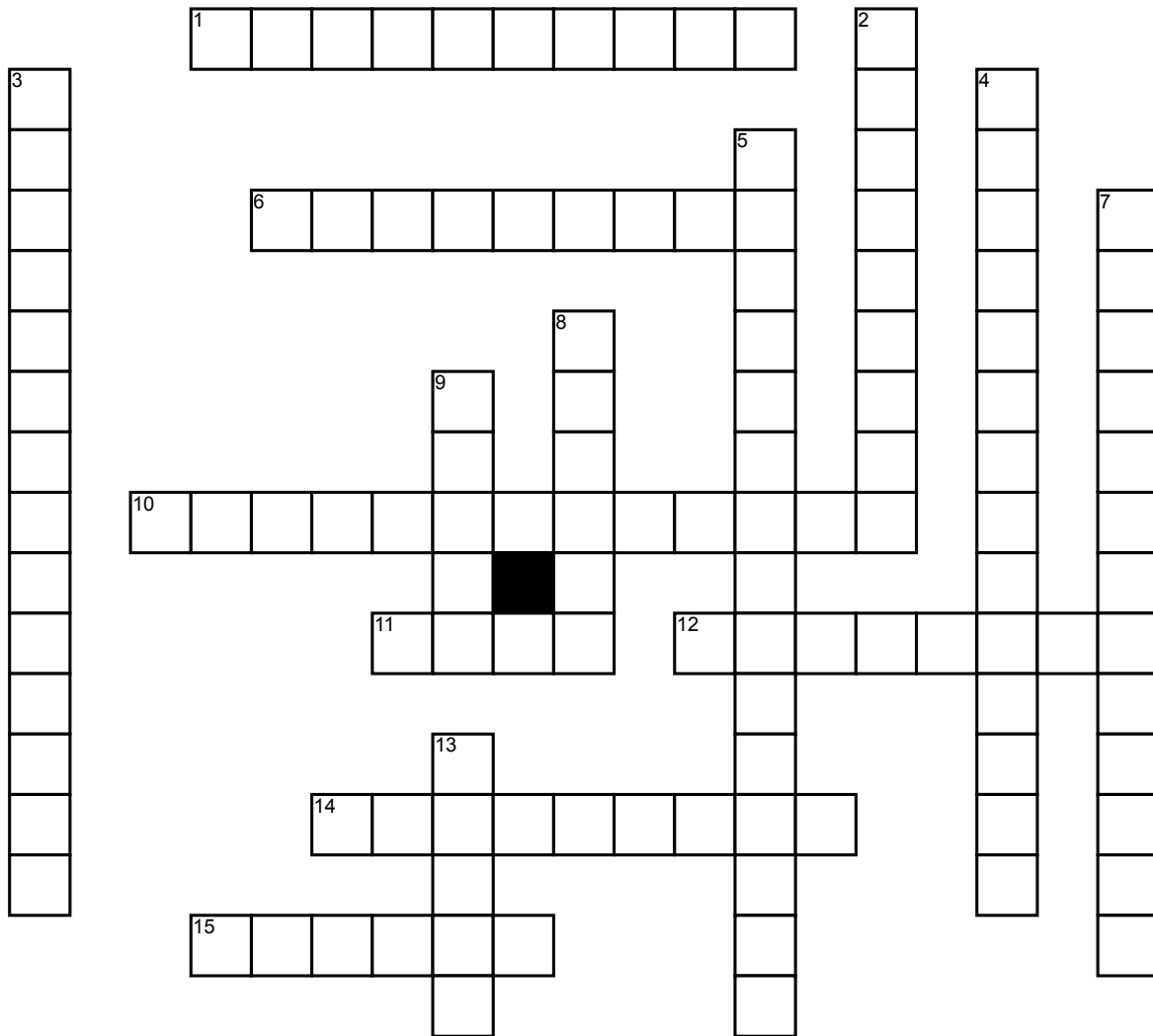

**1.** The lower area of the stomach where the duodenum and stomach meet

**6.** A PAINFUL BURNING SENSATION IN THE CHEST CAUSED BY STOMACH ACID BACKING UP INTO THE ESOPHAGUS.

**10.** OCCUR WHEN THE IMMUNE SYSTEM REACTS TO SUBSTANCES IN FOOD AS THOUGH THEY WERE HARMFUL "FOREIGN INVADERS."

**11.** -muscular sphincter which controls the exit of waste

**12.** secretes insulin which breaks down sugars

**14.** The area where the stomach meets the esophagus

**15.** stores waste before it is expelled from the body

**2.** The large area on the left side of the stomach

**3.** absorption of nutrients

**4.** a "curtain-like" membrane that covers the intestines, stores fat and lays like a drape

**5.** increase surface area for absorption of nutrients

**7.** Consists of liver, gallbladder, ducts Functions to create bile used in digestion

**8.** SORES IN THE LINING OF THE STOMACH OR DUODENUM THAT ARE USUALLY CAUSED BY BACTERIAL INFECTIONS.

**9.** 4 sections, ascending / transverse / descending / sigmoid

**13.** start of large intestine, has an attached appendix
