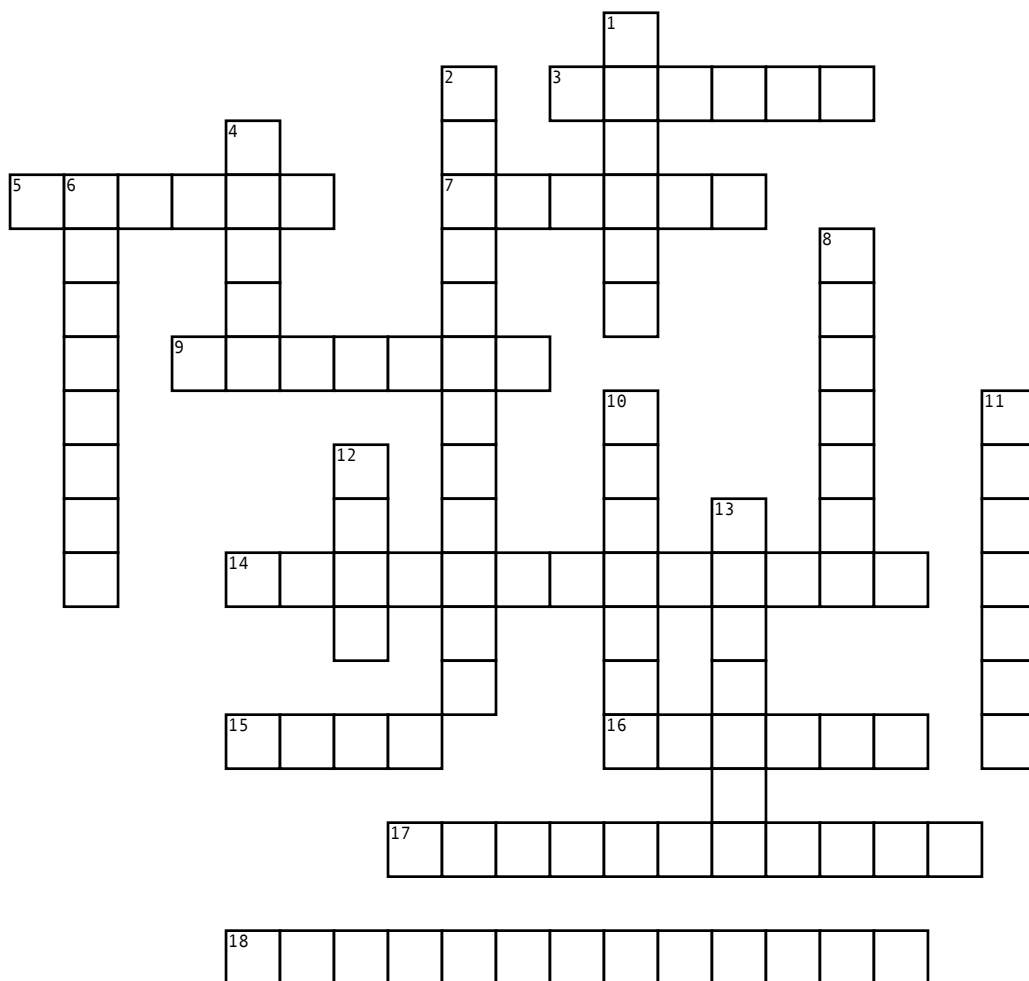


# Ancient Egypt
