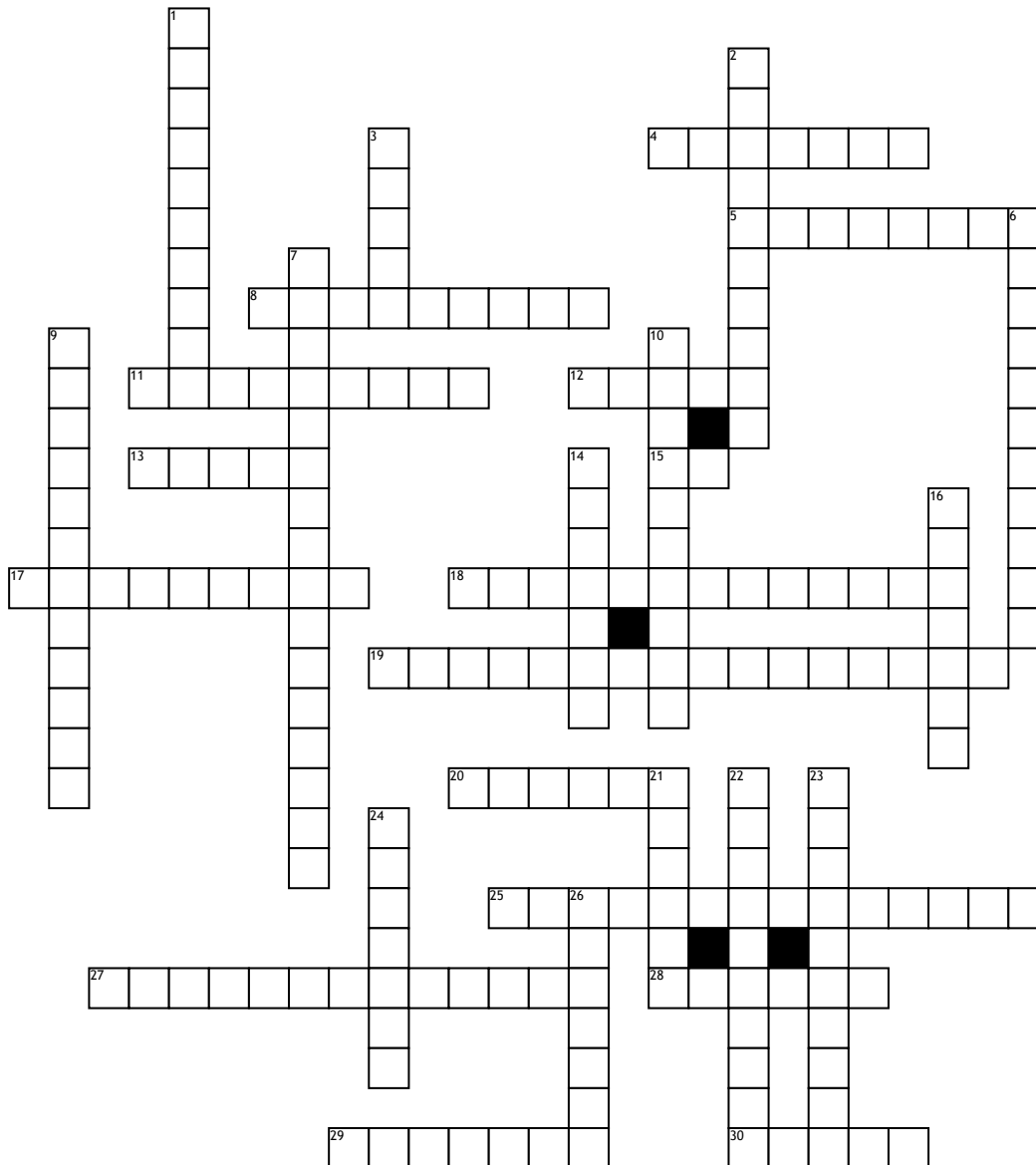


Ancient Egypt Crossword Puzzle
