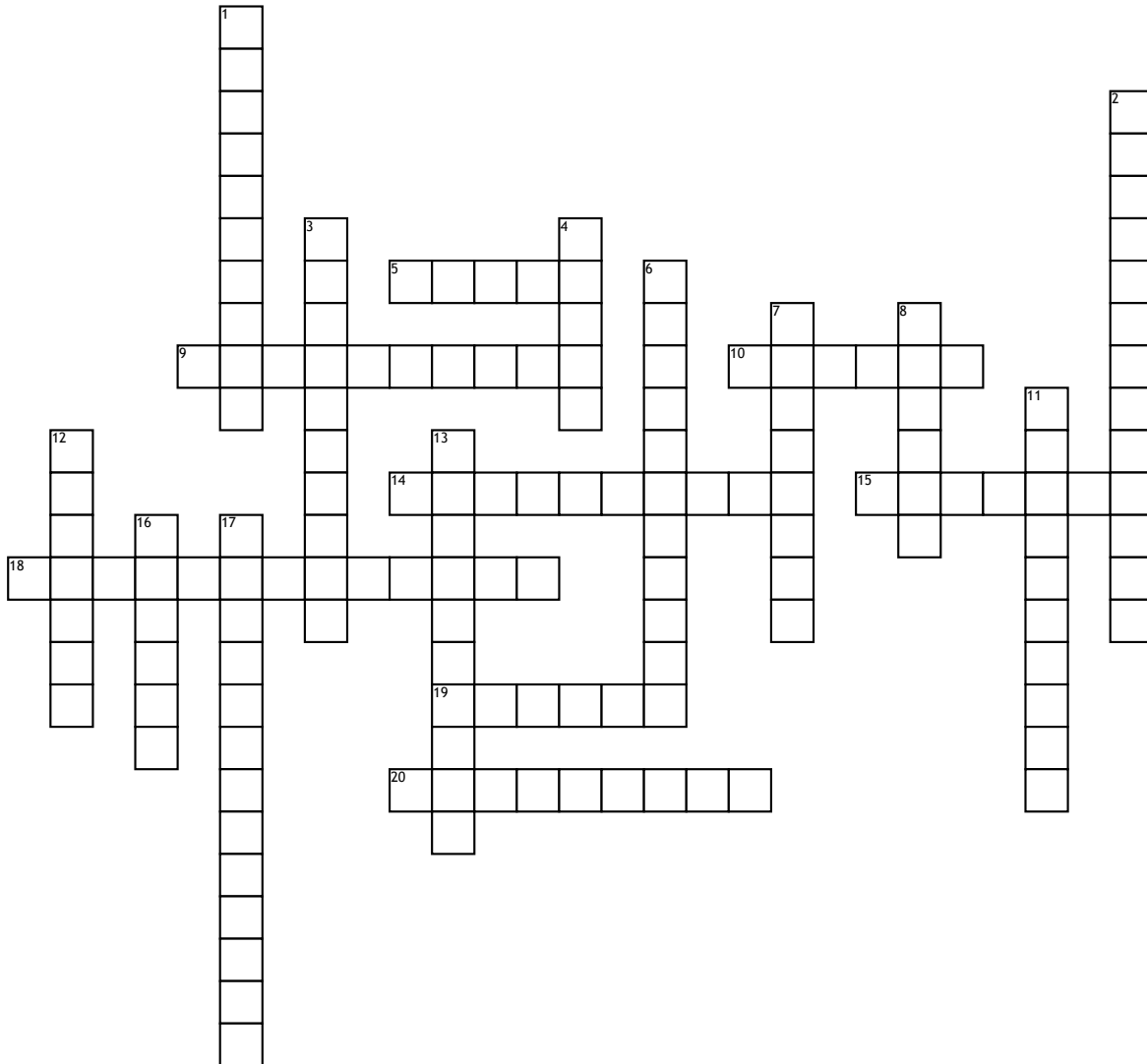


Ancient Egypt

18. Name given by archeologists to the earlier periods of a culture

1. Was given its name in the 3rd millennium CB when Egypt obtained its peak in civilization
2. a process in which the skin and flesh of a corpse can be preserved
3. Sometimes described as dynasty 00
4. relating to or denoting a group of Niger-Congo languages spoken in central and southern Africa, including Swahili, Xhosa, and Zulu.
6. designating or pertaining to a pictographic script, particularly that of the ancient Egyptians, in which many of the symbols are conventionalized, recognizable pictures of the things represented.

7. Can be used as a tomb for ancient pharaohs

8. an Afroasiatic language of Egypt descended from ancient Egyptian

11. a system of society or government in which the father or eldest male is head of the family and descent is traced through the male line

13. an ancient ruined city in North Egypt, on the Nile delta

16. an ancient city in Upper Egypt, on the Nile, whose ruins are located in the modern towns of Karnak and Luxor
