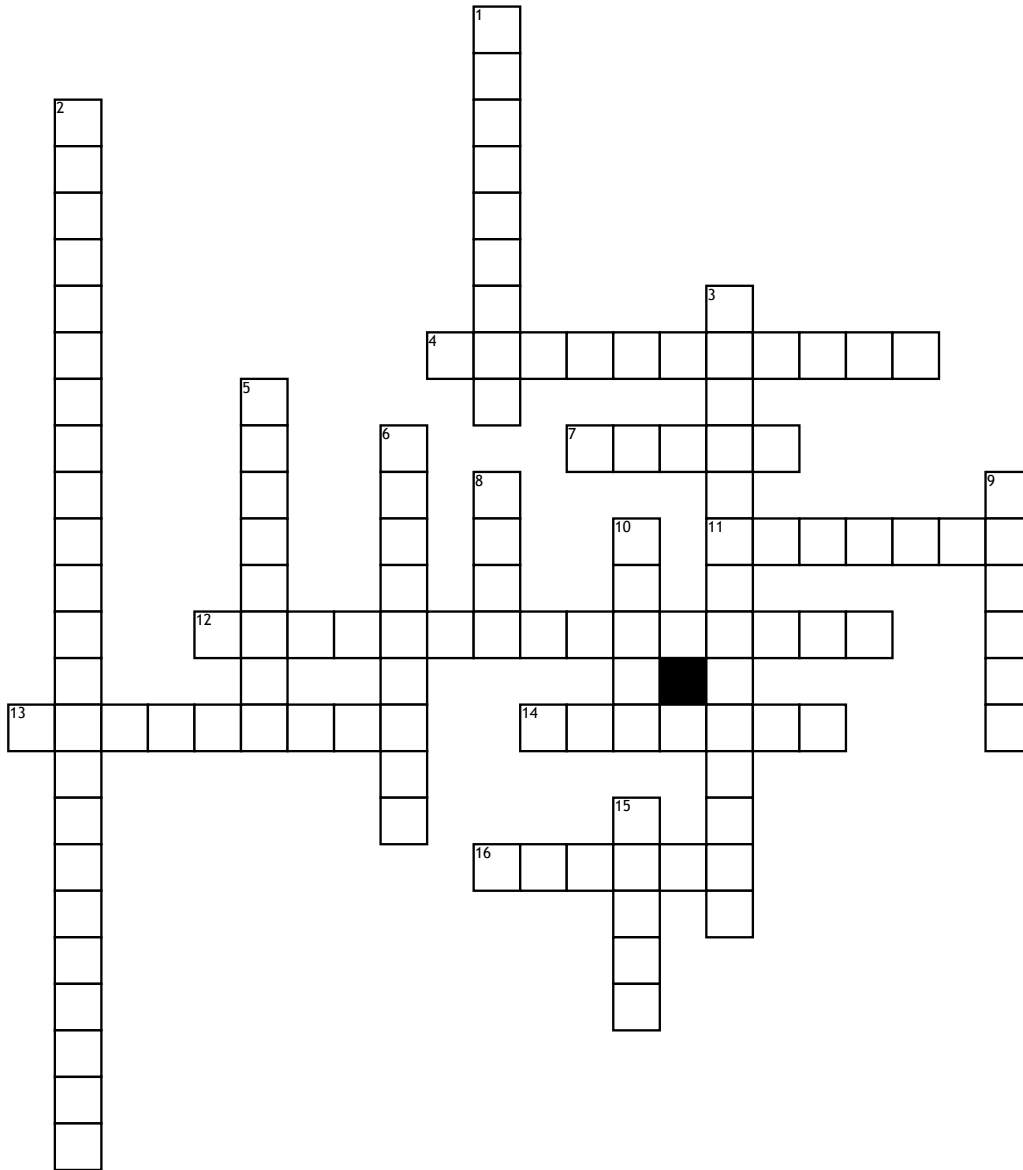


# Ancient Greece
