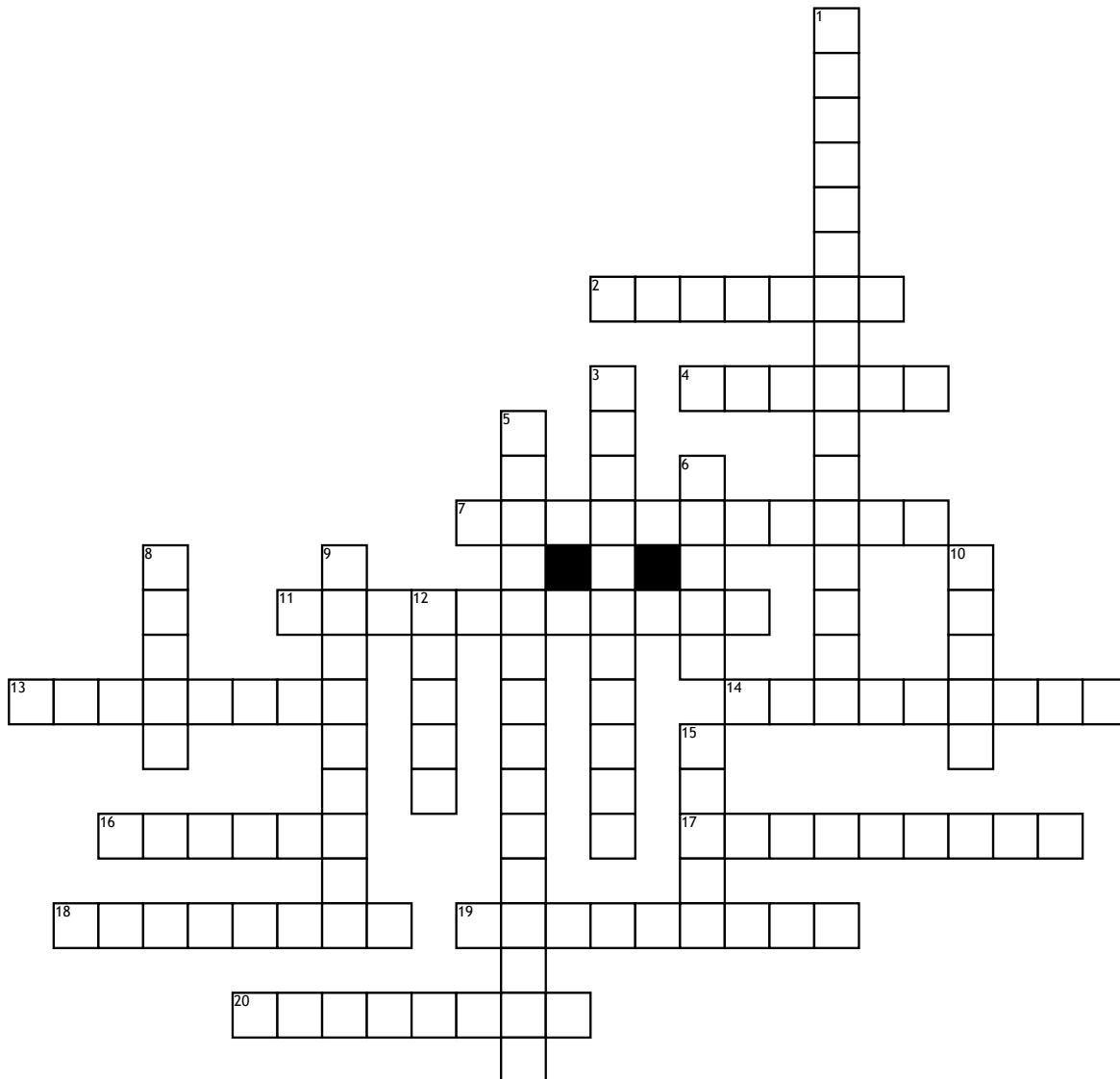


Ancient Greece and Iran Crossword
