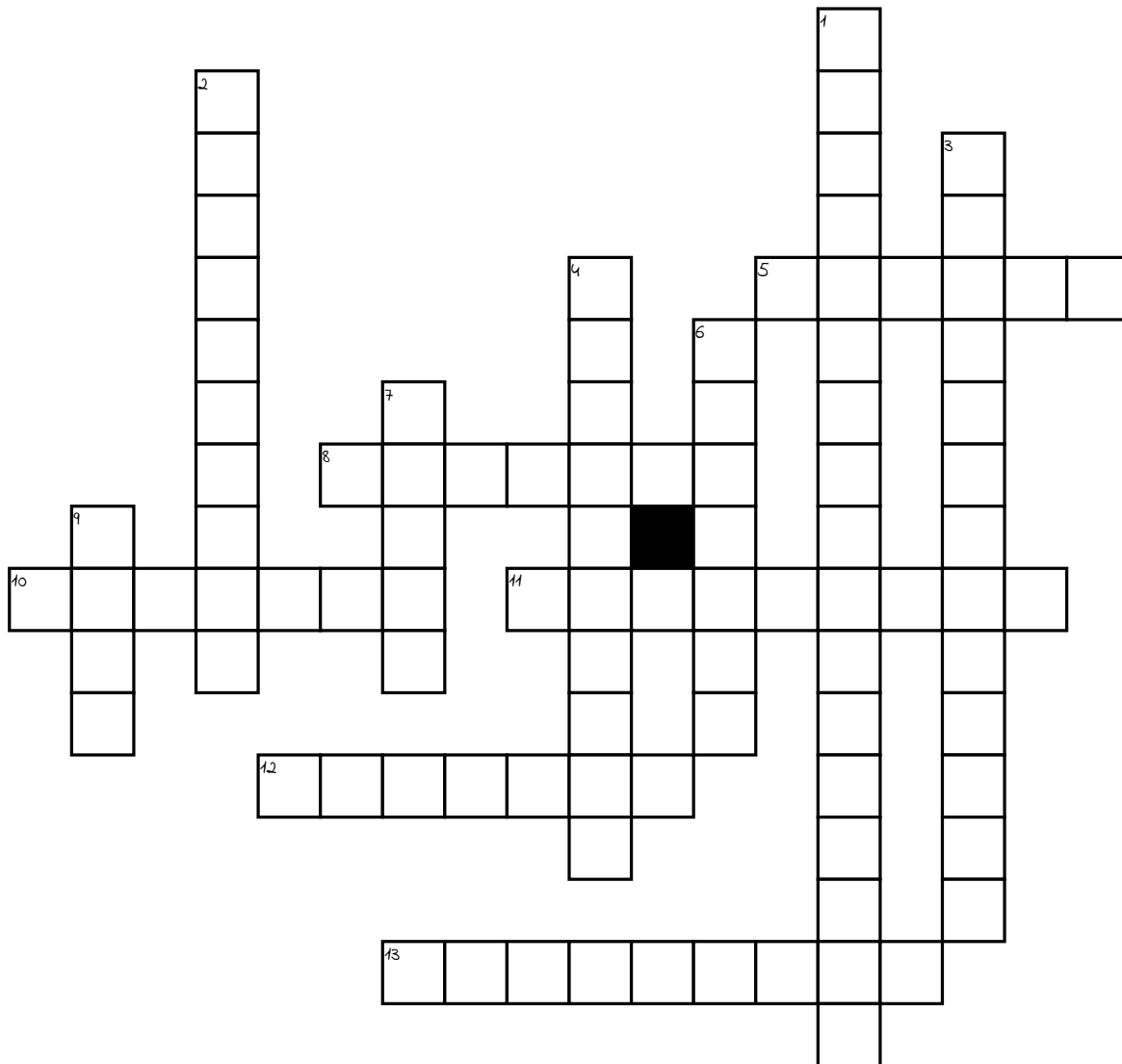


# Ancient Persia
