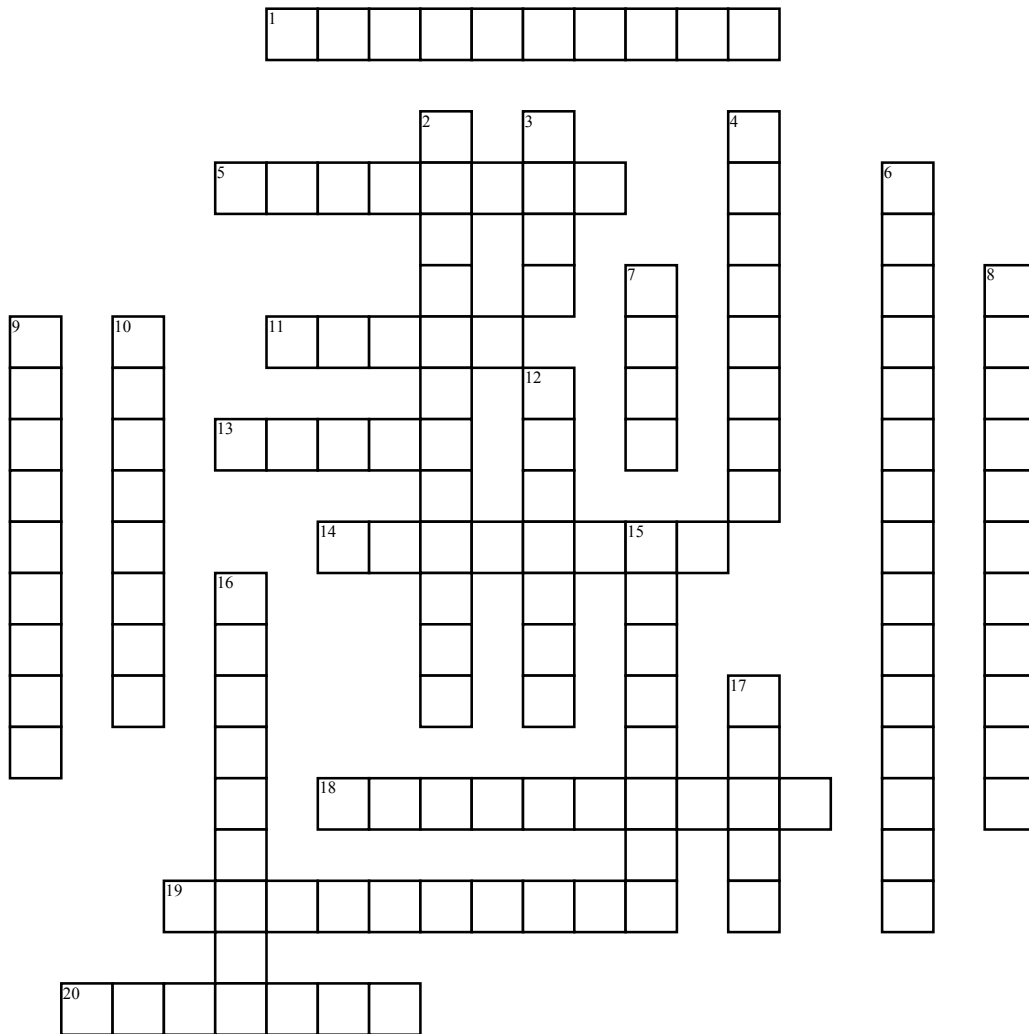


# Ancient Rome Crossword Puzzle
