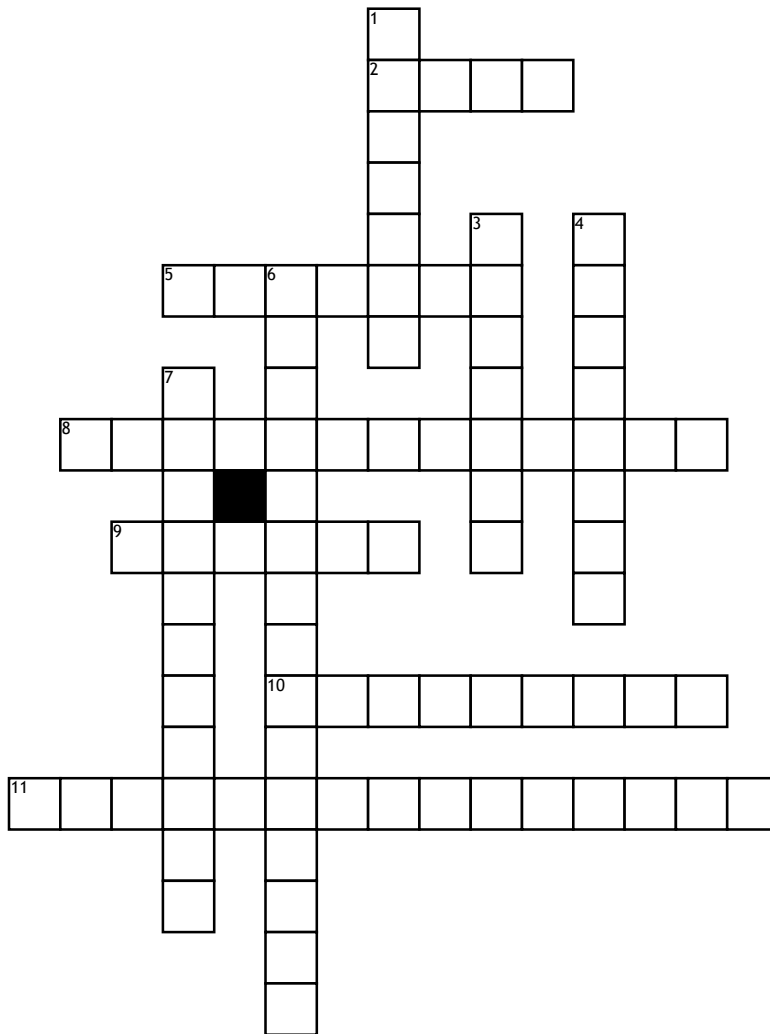

Across

2. the medial bone of the forearm
 5. triangular shaped shoulder blade
 8. lateral aspect of scapula which serves as point of articulation with the humerus
 9. lateral bone of the forearm
 10. 14 total; four digits each consisting of proximal, middle, and distal bone, the pollex having only two; each
 11. process on the anterior, superior side of scapula near the glenoid cavity extending laterally

Down

1. long bone of the upper arm
 3. consisting of eight wrist bones arranged into two rows of four
 4. slender curved bone which connects the scapula to the sternum
 6. scapular process extending laterally from the spine of the scapula, articulates with the clavicle
 7. five bones forming the palm
