

- **2.** a well that doesn't require a pump to bring water to the surface
- **6.** A deep vertical hole of small diameter bored into the earth to ascertain the nature of the underlying strata or to obtain water
- **9.** the level below which the ground is saturated with water
- **11.** the volume of water flowing through a river channel
- **13.** a trough or fold of stratified rock in which the strata slope upwards from the axis

**14.** where gaps between soil are filled with both air and water.

- 1. an accumulation of groundwater that is above the water table in the unsaturated zone
