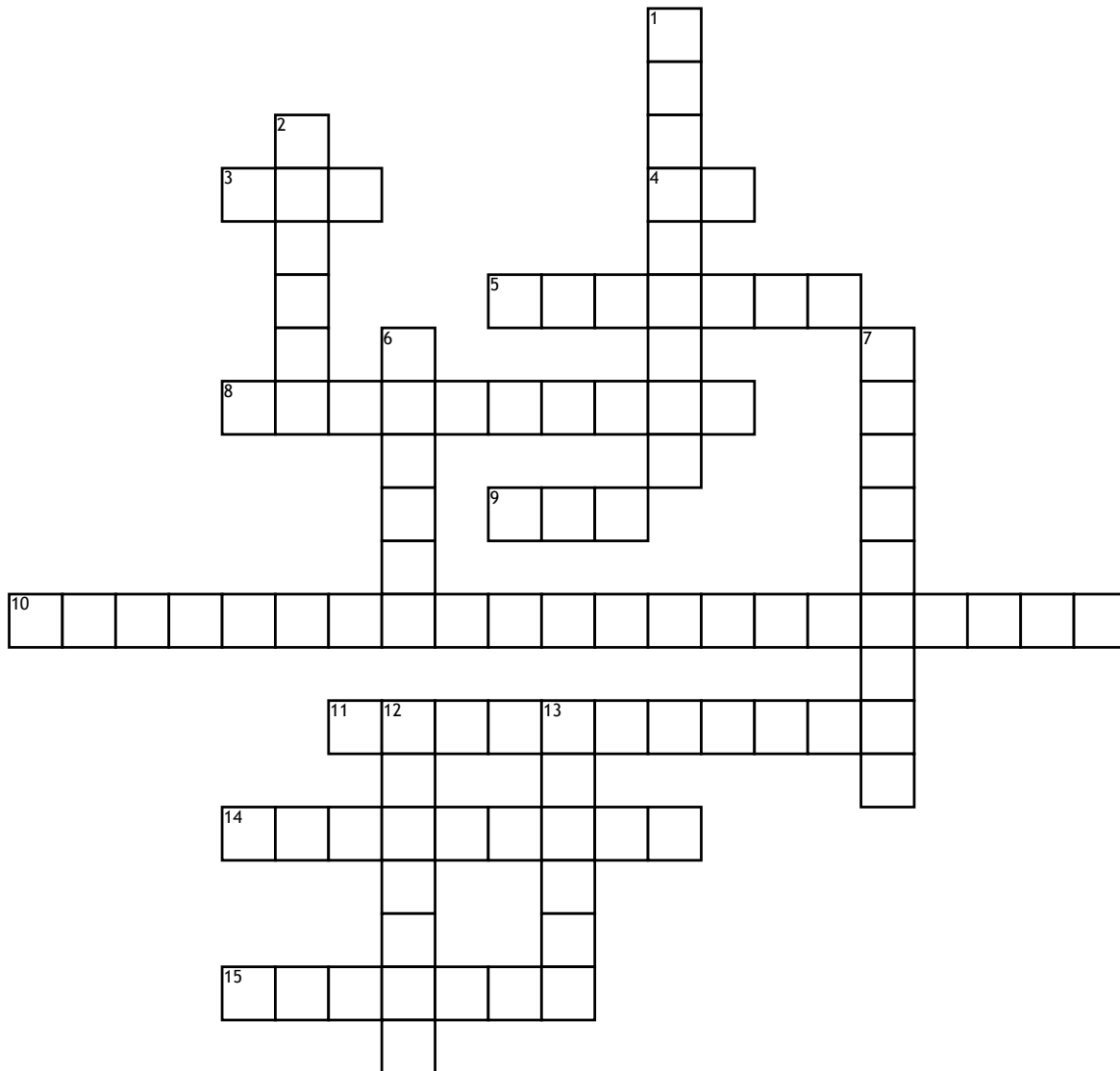

15. refers to a (usually abnormal) rhythm of the heart on auscultation, like a gallop

Down

1. indicator of a possible heart attack, but it may also be a symptom of another condition or problem

2. Blowing or swishing sound due to a turbulent blood flow

6. regular or irregular

7. shortness of breath (dyspnea) that occurs when lying flat, causing the person to have to sleep propped up in bed or sitting in a chair.

12. vibrations detected on palpation

13. strong outward thrust of the chest wall during systole, results from an enlarged ventricle
